Receipts today, however, were 38,700 at 12 principal markets. This compared with 20,600 a week ago today and 28,300 a year ago today. Yesterday's receipts at the same markets were 41,100, far below the preceding Monday—but Monday usually is a much heavier day for receipts than Tuesday.

Some observers said, however, that it was too early to judge the effect of the cattle ceiling order, which is part of the government's campaign to cut meat prices.

The full effect of the order by the Office of Price Stabilization, one OPS official said, cannot be judged until next week. Actually, the cattle price ceilings are not in effect for most buyers. The OPS order calls for payment by packers of prices to average 10 per cent below those of January during the accounting periods, which began May 20 or thereafter.

Bowers School O.K'd By Board of Education

Formal Action Taken So That Application May Be Made for State Grant of \$123,000

After voting formal approval of the new Bowers school so that application can be made for a state grant estimated at \$123,000, the Board of Education last night dis-

counted the estimated enrollment for next September to 700, and this figure will undoubtedly swell by next September.

The superintendent stated that at the opening of school last fall, the total kindergarten enrollment was 448. Although the next formal registration period will not be held until the last week of August, school authorities feel that, based on past experience, the 700 figure of May 10 will show a definite and possibly heavy increase by September.

Must Be Transported
The children will again have to be transported to schools outside their areas in order to take advantage of existing classroom facilities. Overlooked at Nathan Hale and Hollister schools for example, will be children from the South and Buckland schools respectively.

Figures on the recent kindergarten enrollment indicate that the end of Manchester School building needs is not yet in sight. Mr. Hing reported that the May 10 kindergarten registration has

been reported at Nathan Hale, Hollister, Manchester Green and Verplanck schools: Lincoln, 54; Bowers, 80; Nathan Hale, 94; Hollister, 106; Robbeton, 84; Green, 80; Verplanck 192; Silver Lake, 45; Waabington, 54; Highland Park, 35; South, 18; and Buckland, 9.

The biggest increase will probably be in the Manchester Green area as the many new homes are occupied upon completion.

Budget Is Discussed
The Board of Education spent some time last night in discussion of another issue which is greatly affected by school expansion—the 1951-52 budget. A final draft of the budget must be submitted to General Manager George H. Waddell by June 1.

The cost of a swollen school enrollment is not fully met with the erection of new schools. More teachers must be hired, more supplies purchased, and maintenance costs have to increase. An increase over the current budget appears inevitable.

In other action last night, the school board voted a slight salary increase to summer school teachers.

However, Taft said, he did not think the Russians "intend to do so, because I believe that they do not desire to risk destruction of Communism when they believe that they can ultimately conquer the world without war."

And yet, Taft added, "The administration refuses to fight the Korean war with all the means at its command, on the theory that we might invite Russia to start a third world war."
