**3 Dead, 5 Safe
 In B-29 Crash**

Near Antonio Tex., June 22. - Because someone apparently forgot to check the parachute, three crewmen died in the fiery explosion of a Superfortress yesterday.

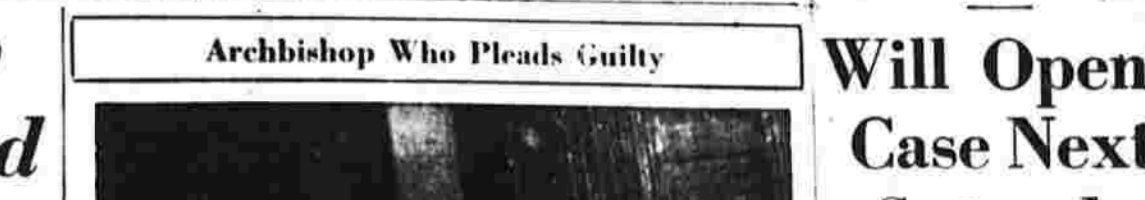
