### Green School Urgent Need

#### House Says New Building Can Be Erected As Fast as Addition

The pressing problem in the Manchester Green area is the erection of an 18-room school. Chairman Charles S. House of the Board of Education told a joint meeting of the educators, Board of Directors and Town Planning Commission. He added that steps should be taken to purchase land adjoining the existing Green school for a future addition at that site.

House was answering a question by Director Harry Pirato as to whether it might not be advisable to build an addition to the existing school first to care for the immediate needs of the area and follow later with the purchase of land for the addition, and that a new school could be built just as quickly.

**Land Fund Provided**  
The directors recently authorized General Manager George H. Waddell to include the sum of \$17,500 in his 1951-52 budget for the purchase of approximately 20 acres of land in the Vernon-Loyal streets area for the Green school. A recent appraisal of properties adjacent to the Green school estimated that the purchase of this land would cost approximately \$44,000, and Martin E. Alvord of the Planning Commission estimated that the purchase of these properties and raising existing buildings would total \$70,000.

William F. Buckley, chairman of the Library board and a member of the Board of Education, suggested a branch library for the Green area and one of the homes on the adjacent properties could be remediated for that purpose. Director T. J. Crockett predicted that "we're going to run into a lot of trouble buying these properties."

**Two Year Project**  
Raymond Goales, chairman of the School Building committee, predicted it would be two years before the proposed Green school will be built. Directors Melvin Hathaway and Katherine Bonn suggested a quick start to the Green building project, and Hathaway suggested

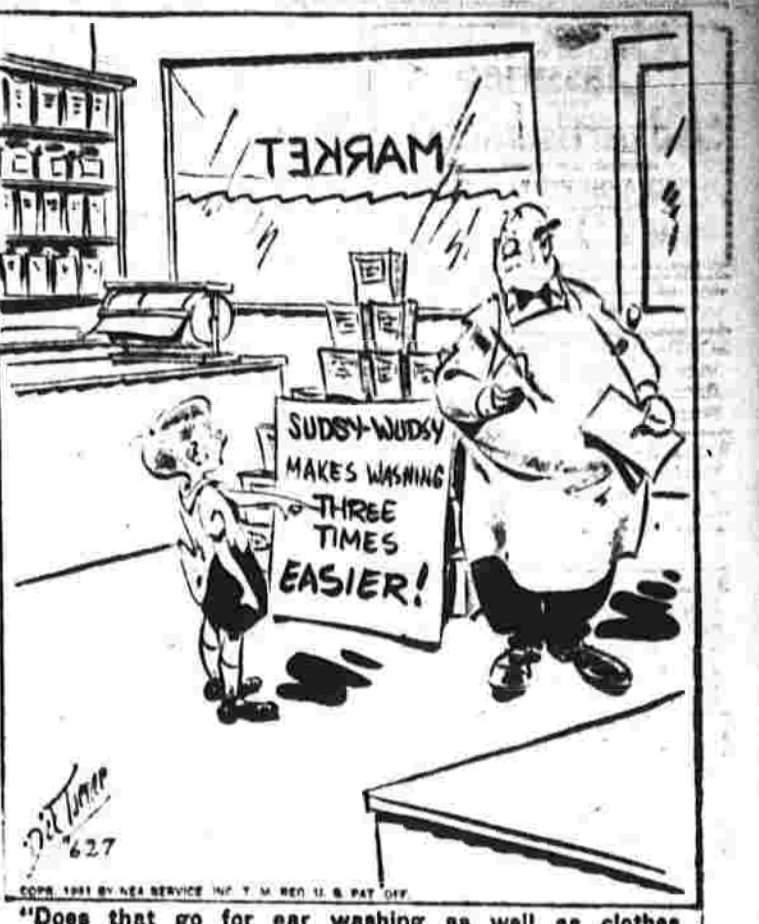
