11. Do you have an adequate supply of ash trays?

would ask the Mexican government to let Hall stay in Mexico as a political refugee.

But early today he was brought across the border. Newsman Tom Green of the Laredo Times watched as five men in an old model four-door sedan with Mexican license plates drove across the International Bridge here at 3 a. m.

The FBI didn't say where Hall was being held. Federal prisoners here are kept in the Wash County jail here, but jail officers weren't talking. The resident FBI agent, L. C. Taylor, wasn't available for immediate comment.

The sale will be conducted on a fifty-fifty basis, with the owner stating the price he feels the article should sell for, and sharing the purchase price equally with the Hospital Auxiliary.

Articles for the consignment sale may be brought to the American Legion hall on November 14 and 15 from 10 a. m. to 5 p. m. Each article will be catalogued

and numbered, and the merchandise will be covered by insurance during the period of the sale. No clothes will be accepted, but the field of salvable merchandise is otherwise almost unlimited. It covers surplus gifts and glassware, which has accrued on closet shelves, bicycles and baby carriages that have been outgrown, pictures or furniture set aside on re-decorating, or antiques and jewelry to brighten the eye of some amateur collector.

Where Is Truth?

As we noted the other day, his own appearance, and the anxiety to answer his charges at all costs, Ambassador-elect, Mr. Stassen and the State Department into a mood in which, for the sake of a point blank denial, they blabbered out the first thing that came into their heads. The whole truth, rather than defend whatever position they might have taken during the period in question, they chose to deny that the position had ever existed. 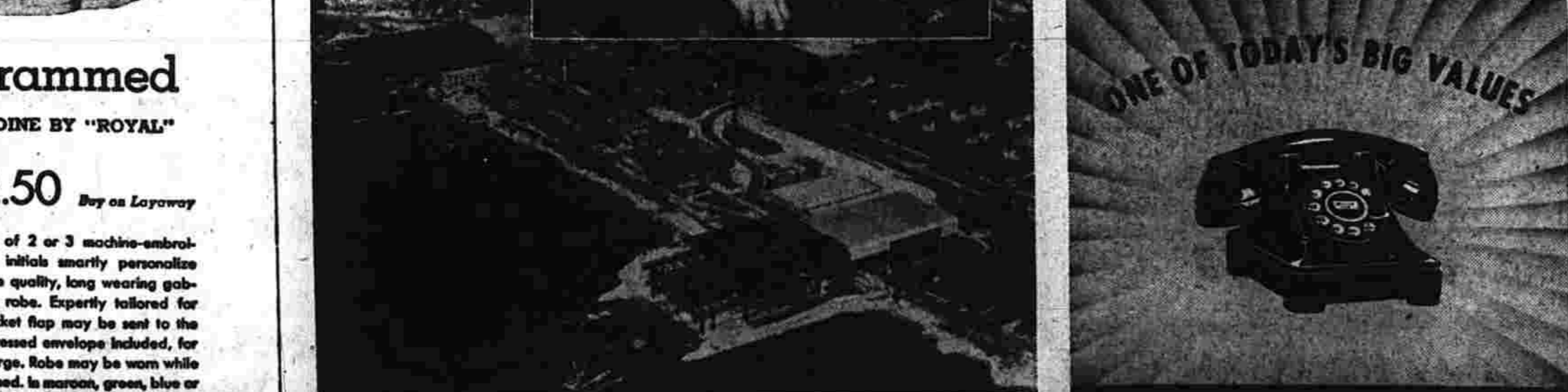

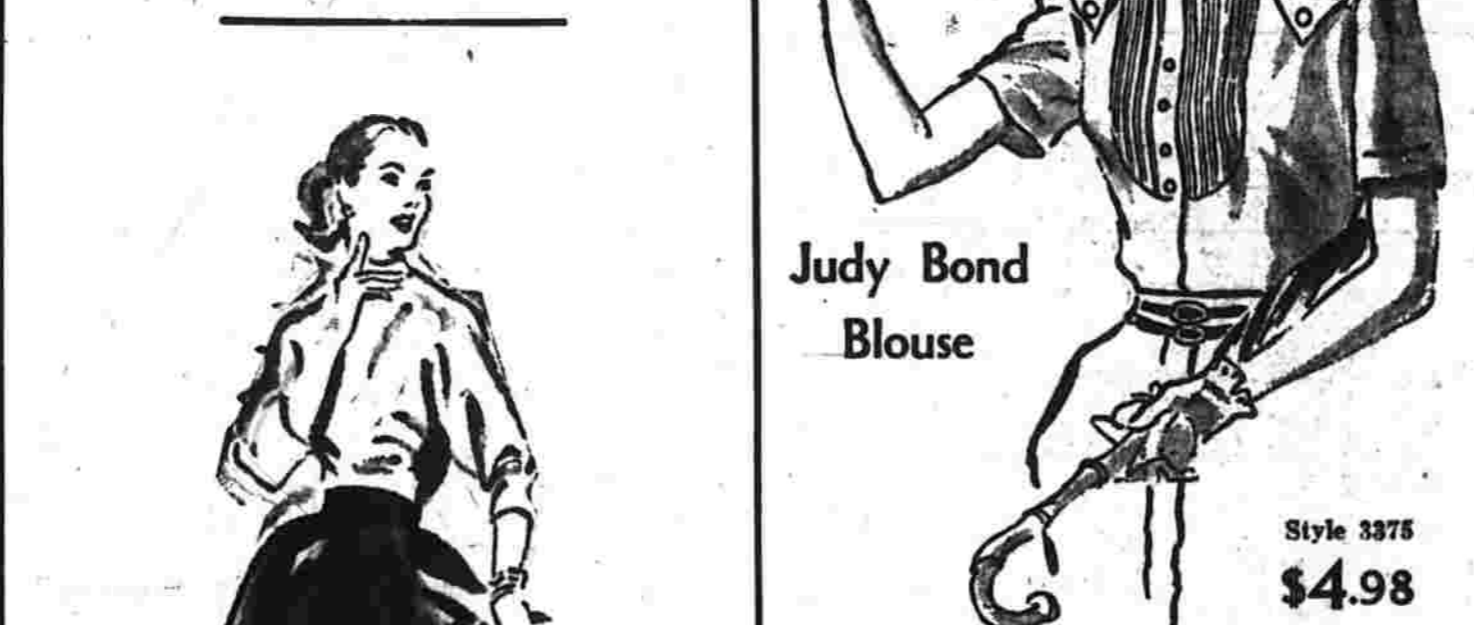

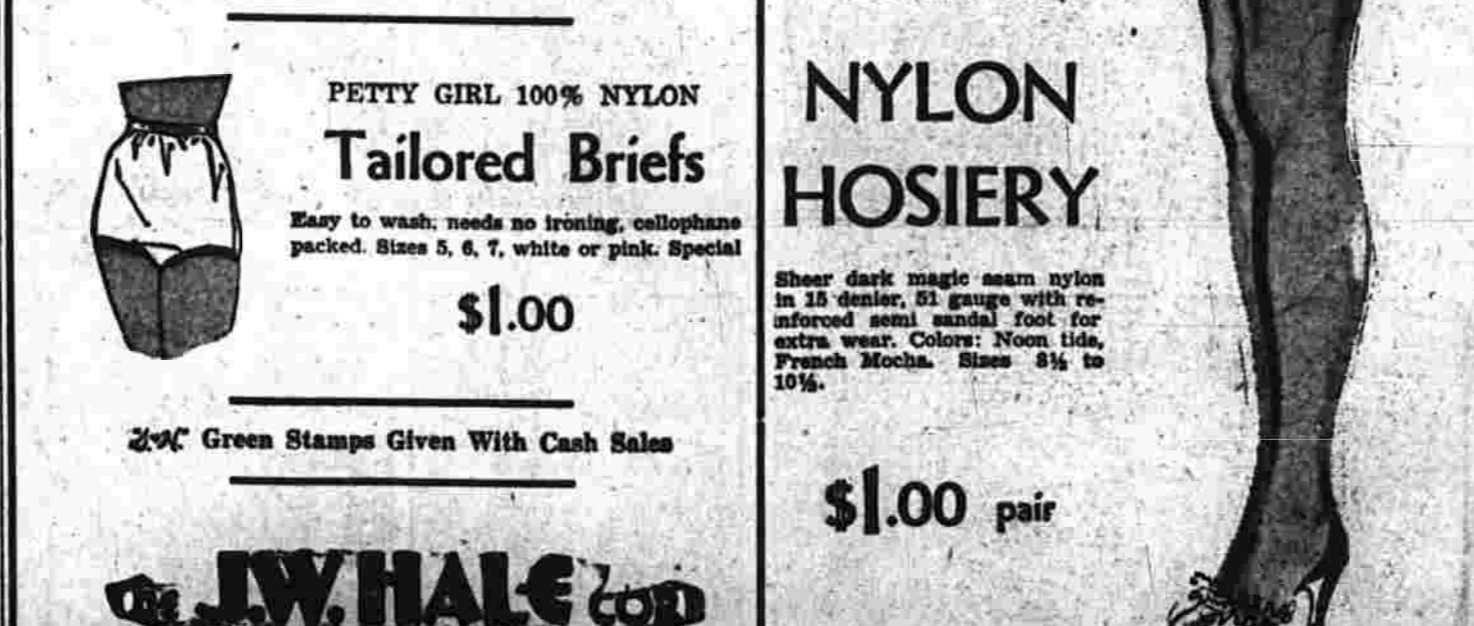
