**Hartford Man Lands in Jail**

Resists Arrest After Officer Tedford Investigates Disturbance

Daniel Delaney, 28, of Hartford, no certain address, landed in jail last night after resisting arrest following a disturbance at 15 Drive A, Silver Lane Home, Patriman-Fredrick Tedford investigated a complaint by Mrs. Alfred Logan who told police Delaney was making a nuisance of himself and threatening physical abuse and destruction of property. Mrs. Logan ordered Delaney to leave the premises during an argument that developed between Delaney and Mrs. Logan's sister, Mrs. Alice Gray. Upon refusal, the police were called.

Patriman Tedford said he tried to settle the dispute and advise Delaney to leave quietly and no charge would be made against him. Delaney, Tedford said, offered to give him a good excuse for arresting him if he took one step closer. As the policeman advanced toward Delaney, the latter allegedly started kicking and throwing punches and a battle ensued. When Delaney was released, he was taken to Police Headquarters and booked for breach of peace and resisting arrest. He remained in jail overnight and was released today under a \$200 bond for appearance in Town Court Monday morning.

porters said they are not surprised by a copyrighted story of the Milwaukee Journal saying that Gen. Douglas MacArthur has informed Wisconsin Republican leaders he favors Senator Taft (R-Ohio).

Aides of MacArthur in New York City said he had met with Wisconsin Republican leaders but all they would not confirm or deny the story he supports Taft.

Ives said the Milwaukee story and a report in Taft by political advisers that he could win the nomination "simply serve as a warning to Eisenhower supporters that they must redouble their efforts to beat Taft."

Taft has not yet formally announced his candidacy but has promised to make a definite statement soon, possibly next week. Most observers expect him to run.

**General Indispensable**

Morse, in a Senate speech, came out strongly for Eisenhower last night after Senator Brewster, R-Me., an ardent Taft backer, said the general was indispensable on his present assignment as commander of North Atlantic Defense Forces in Western Europe.

Brewster said he could "not picture General Eisenhower turning tail" and leaving Europe next spring when, he declared, there would be critical danger of a Russian invasion.

Morse replied Eisenhower was "not indispensable in his position." He said that, in any other position, he said that, "where political opponents want to keep him, they will keep him."

Morse, who often differs with Republican leaders, said he "could think of no other man who would cause greater dissent in our country and cause more uncertainty and disturbance than to have nominated at the Republican convention next summer a reactionary Republican."

**Other Developments**

Elsewhere, there were these political developments: Republican State Senator Jack H. Tenney announced formation of an organization called Americans for MacArthur. He called the general "our best hope to save America from the political corruption that has enveloped us."

In New York, an organization was formed to "draft" Taft for the GOP nomination. Chairman Frank A. Scovyn, pharmaceutical manufacturer, said a campaign will be started to convince voters that Taft, "far from being the reactionary his enemies claim he is, is in reality a high-minded liberal Wisconsin Republican leader but all."

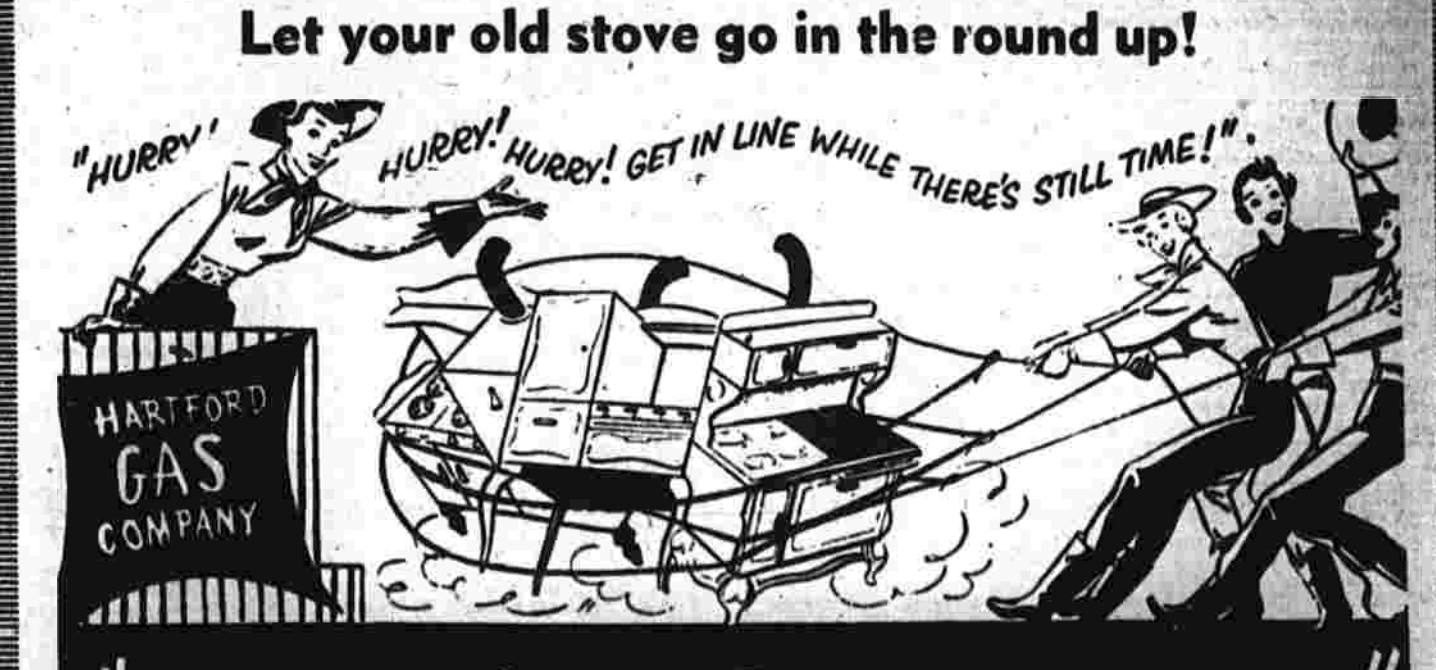
