This missing figure has been reduced to a current total of about 10,500. Among these are the some 2,500 Americans reported by Col. James M. Hensley, chief of the War Crimes Section of the U. S. 8th Army in Korea, who said that 10,000 of the 12,000 killed by the Chinese were killed by their captors.
