tion for the projected common army, he declared, "must be a joint elected deliberative body with powers even of decision and control."

This joint parliament, he continued, should exercise its authority through a "supreme college" supported from the common military budget.

A "considerable part" of these funds, the Italian premier asserted, should come from the home of each participating nation over proceeds of a state monopoly—the tobacco monopoly, for example—to the common military budget.

De Gasperi's statement was the first word from one of the European army planners on the manner in which the force would be financed. The Italian meets here tomorrow with ministers of the other five governments involved in the plan—France, The Netherlands, Belgium, Luxembourg and West Germany—to take up the other issues still undecided in the plan.

Urging support of the army plan, he said, "We must not go beyond the absolutely necessary point. But to reach this point, we should shut no trouble or toil."

**3 German States Vote for Merger**

Stuttgart, Germany, Dec. 10.—Three small German states have voted to form one big new state covering the entire southwest corner of Germany.

Voters of the three states approved the merger overwhelmingly in a plebiscite yesterday. The vote was 748,138 to 708,518. The Allied High Commission is considered certain to approve the outcome.

The new state with a total population of 6,500,000 stretches from Heidelberg on the north to Bwiersand on the south and from Tim West to the French border. It becomes the fourth largest state in all West Germany, which now will have nine states instead of 11.

It will be several months before a new constitution can be drawn and a new parliament elected to put the new state into operation.

The new state has not yet been named, but its capital probably will be Stuttgart.
