Kelley said that the new law in Connecticut appears to be in order. A hand signal is not required in Connecticut in 1951. The wording but not the intent of the law has been changed over the years and now includes the need for a signal when drawing away from the curb or edge of the highway. The 1917 law is quoted below since it is written in simpler language than the present law.

function of the courts. Over the years with the many cases that have been decided in which signals were involved, the courts have interpreted the signal law as follows: A hand signal is not required in preference to mechanical signals to conform with the law. The signal must be made conspicuously in advance of the stop or turn so as to give other operators plenty of time to control their vehicles; the signals must be adequate, definite and understandable.

Two Signals  
From this it can be inferred that an adequate signal given by means of the stop light for a stop and the arrow type or flashing light turn signals may conform to the law just as well as a hand signal. However, the Commissioner states, some situations require that the operator give a hand signal as well as a flashing light signal in order to be sure that his intention of turning or stopping is understood by other drivers.

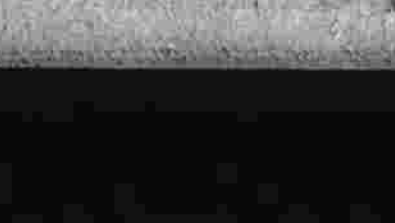

Kindergarten enrollment was unexpectedly large, 28 children were already enrolled. This increase will necessitate use of what is known as the stagger system, by which each child will attend classes only four days per week. School enrollment before this standing at about 242, the entire school enrollment now reaches 270 and perhaps more, a record for the town. The unexpected increase will mean that the basement will again have to be called into use as a class room another year, in spite of the fact that a new room addition has only recently been completed to take care of the swollen number. Kindergarten sessions will open Dec. 28.
