





### Recommend Town Develop More Parks, Playgrounds

A park and playground development program that would bring the number of acres used for these purposes in Manchester up to the minimum required by the National Municipal League is recommended by the Board of Directors of the Recreation and Park Commission.

The report, which is dated Dec. 28, suggests the development of park and playground use of about 100 acres, some of which would be recently acquired by the National Recreation Association, which prescribes one acre of park and playground space for each 100 of the local population.

Recommendations made in the report include:

1. Oak Grove street property, 87 acres. This property, recently purchased by the town for park and playground use, would be used for certain park and water recreation uses at the same time.
2. Keeney street school site, 27 acres. The commission recommends the use of 15 acres here for playground facilities that would be in the care of the playground commission.
