Hartford, Jan. 23.—At the request of Governor Lodge a "watch" is being kept on Connecticut's fuel oil situation to avoid any possible shortages. The Governor conferred with

Charles H. Mitchell, chairman of the Fuel Oil Advisory Committee Tuesday afternoon and asked him to "keep a careful eye on our fuel prospects."

"We are watching the situation very closely in order that a shortage should not be caught napping," the Governor said.

Mr. Mitchell assured the Governor that there appears to be a sufficient stock in Connecticut's heating oil and pointed out that householders in this state started the season with at least 9,000,000 more gallons in their tanks than a year ago.

Mr. Mitchell pointed out that a shortage area will be due to transportation problems due to increased shipping rates rather than lack of fuel.

American officials had expressed fear Russia, for espionage purposes, might claim payment of the fliers' expenses to Germany to induce them to return to the United States in order to free the men. "The fliers proved they were spies sent by Klenbow," he said.

Discussion of the fliers came up in a debate over admission of new members to the United Nations. The fliers' flight was the subject of a speech by the Russian representative.

U. S. delegate Ernest Gruen said yesterday one way Hungary could prove her eligibility for UN membership would be to return the verdict and refund the fliers' expenses, the Russian speaker said.

Russia previously has vetoed eight UN applicants—Italy, Austria, Finland, Iceland, Portugal, Jordan, Ceylon and West Germany. The Russians had offered to accept the West would admit five Soviet satellites—Bulgaria, Albania, Romania, Hungary and Czechoslovakia.

The United States and other western nations called the proposal "blackmail and turned it down," they said. The Communist candidate would be "peacocking" as required by the charter.
