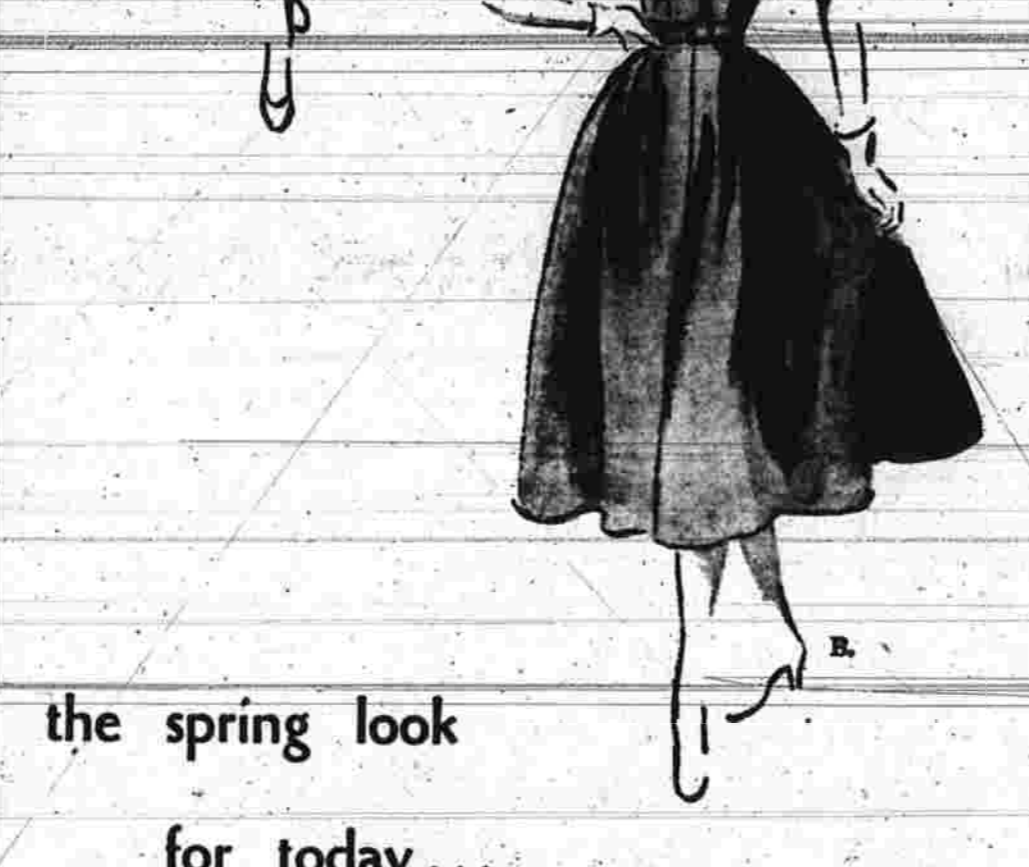

Your 1951 Taxes... Filing Form 1040-A And Short Form. (Editor's Note: This is the eighth of 10 stories explaining how to make out your 1951 income tax return.)

By JAMES HULLO... You do not figure. Answer the questions. You pay no money when you turn it in, even though you will figure your tax for you.

1. If husband and wife make a joint return, both must sign it. 2. Be sure when you hand in your return that you attach to it all the receipts—Form W-2 given you by a boss as proof of what he paid you and how much tax he withheld from you last year.

3. Be careful under Item No. 1 on both forms to claim all the exemptions to which you're entitled. For each you knock \$500 off your taxable income. (1) your income, and (2) the number of exemptions claimed on your return.

4. Remember that Form 1040-A can be used for reporting income under \$5,000. If you're reporting more income than that, you can't use either of those forms. You must use the 1040 form form where you figure your own tax.

5. Everyone using 1040-A or the short form automatically gets a deduction for personal expenses of about 10 per cent. He gets it automatically. He doesn't have to claim it or itemize it. It's allowed for in the table used to figure the tax on people using those forms.

6. If your income was under \$5,000 but your deductible expenses were more than 10 per cent, then use the 1040 long form where you'll get a deduction for personal expenses.

### UConn Grad Ends Pensions Survey

Storrs, Feb. 6.—The first survey of negotiated pension plans in Connecticut industry has been made by a graduate student at the University of Connecticut and has just been published as a bulletin of the University's Labor-Management Institute.

The completion included details of 14 separate plans and covered most of the negotiated plans in effect last fall.

The survey was made by Ansonia graduate student of economics and under direction of Paul Taylor, assistant professor of economics and Robert L. Stutz, associate professor of labor-management at the University.

The objective study sets forth in simple language the various pension forms in the state brought about as a result of collective bargaining, describing the methods of financing and the types of benefits available.

Myron Clark, director of the Labor-Management Institute, says that the data in the study, now available in booklet form, will be invaluable to those about to establish or initiate negotiated pension plans in the state's manufacturing industry.

### Activity Picks Up At Vets Center
