Solons Hail West Reich In Ike Army

Washington, Feb. 23.—(AP)—Senators today generally approved the decision of the North Atlantic Treaty nations to add German divisions to western Europe's defense forces.

Some said it undoubtedly would help the administration get the additional billions it is asking Congress to appropriate for foreign military and economic aid under the Mutual Security program.

A cut in the requested \$1.5 billion dollars for overseas spending was made through the Foreign Operations bill.

The answer is likely to depend in part on the report Secretary of State Acheson brings back from London on the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) situation.

Subsequent to some creation of an integrated situation, the NATO situation is expected to be clarified.

The European defense army will include a still-to-be-determined number of divisions, as well as other units from France, Italy, Belgium, Holland, and West Germany.

The recruiting of German troops can start, the plan must be ratified by the parliaments of each of the six nations.

Three Democrats on the powerful House Foreign Relations subcommittee hailed NATO acceptance of the European army plan.

The plan calls for a total of 12 divisions, including 10 divisions of the European army and two divisions of the United States.
