Survey Shows Motorists Above Average in Safety

The streets of Manchester were safer places for both motorists and pedestrians in 1931 than were in any other year in the country. This is shown by a survey of data gathered by the National Safety Council from 620 cities with 10,000 or more inhabitants.

The three traffic fatalities in Manchester in 1931, one more than in the previous year, were equivalent to a rate of 8.8 deaths per 100,000 population. This rate was better than that of the nation as a whole, which ended the year with the near-record high of 9.5 fatalities per 100,000 population.
