Leap, Look, And Step Back

We don't know whether it has always been this way with us. But we Americans have a great talent for looking after we leap—only we don't really leap at all. We pretend to be leaping, but all the time, we are reserving freedom of action and later opinion.

We have been thinking of the way the noise has been going on. Federal Judge Belmont's decision. The noise has, we have observed, been in one way—jubilation over the fact that President Truman was cut down to size. We gave over several days to national headspinning over this. Only in one sober quarter, in the column of Arthur Krook in the New York Times, did one find the warning that the First opinion did much more than cut down Truman. Only Krook, it seemed, considered the issue out of the context of vengeance against Truman. But when the issue was so considered, it developed that Judge Pine had not only cut down Mr. Truman, but had issued a sweeping restriction of the powers of all future Presidents.

You wouldn't guess, from the easy atmosphere of reaction to the Pine decision, that this nation will eventually be relieved if it is the Pine decision which is held unconstitutional, even if the price has to be that of labeling Truman's specific act constitutional. But when we get through nodding faces at Mr. Truman, most of us will be glad if the Pine decision is thrown out. Krook's original voice was only one quiet voice among what seemed to be millions of cheers, but that single voice was strongly enough to be found nearer the real American decision than all the loud, and thoughtless, cheers that first went up.

We can catch ourselves playing this game with ourselves over and over again. In the Newbold Morris issue, most of us trumpeted as loudly as we could that there was virtue behind, and our own indignation was high over the fact that Mr. Morris' proposed questionnaire concerning the private finances of all high governmental officials seemed to have been the thing that produced his dismissal.

William Horowitz William Horowitz was a good citizen of two communities, Manchester and Rockville. As such he was a most creditable example of the typical American success story. He was a youthful immigrant whose first success, in a most humble way, the commercial life of this country. Because his mind was an active, organizing mind, which never ceased wondering how things might be done better, he became an entrepreneur, who created industry and employment. With the profits that followed along, he was most generous. Yet, although he achieved success, he never lost his basic interest in the elemental processes—those of finding better ways to multiply the markets of America—in which he first excelled.

Connecticut Yankee

Perhaps the most fascinating detail of the Republican town caucus was not the number of instances in which Tatt or insurgent leaders were defeated in their own home towns, but the story of how one of these leaders survived and managed to come out on top, albeit in somewhat altered guise.

State Comptroller Fred Zeller's home town of Stonington went on record for Eisenhower. Deputy State Comptroller Charles Hager's Middlebury went on record for Eisenhower. Senator Tage Pearson's Wilton went on record for Eisenhower. J. Kenneth Bradley lost a close contest for control of Westport. Former Lieutenant Governor Robert Parsons failed to win a place as a delegate in Farmington.

On these two counts, it might have seemed, by the time of the caucus, that he was considering a switch to the Republican side. But he had recently been re-elected in an effort to obtain Connecticut backing for Senator Tatt.

Daneberg gave his first sample survey strategy a few hours before the caucus. This was an announcement by him that he would support Tatt, but that there would be no difficulty in his switching to the Republican side if he himself was no longer considering accepting the state chairmanship.
