The judges committee for the sixth annual drama festival of the Associated Little Theaters, to be held May 12, 13 and 14 at the Avery Memorial Theater, has selected the judging panel for the competition. The festival, of the Center Theatricals, is being sponsored by the committee, announced today. Assisting the chairman in the selection of festival judges has been Mrs. Edith Moore of the Coventry Players, and Mrs. Nancy Hubbard from the New Britain Repertory Theater.

The panel will consist of H. V. Viggo Andersen, Robert Vogel and Dr. Nathan Spector. Sunday editor of the Hartford Courant and formerly a resident of Manchester, includes in his background, scholastic training at Trinity College and the University of Copenhagen, and also many years of play reviewing.

Robert Vogel, assistant professor of English at Trinity College, is also director of the summer school and of evening classes at that institution.

McGranery Nomination Vote Near

 barrage of questions about presidential powers.

McGranery was recalled for brief speeches today. Edward and McBride were called in later.

The dispute over "presidential powers," shared by Truman's seizure of the strike-threatened steel industry, has become a main issue in the consideration of McGranery's nomination.

At one point McCarran bluntly told the "just and former House member that unless he gave a yes or no answer to a question about the President's powers he friends could not be responsible for his future.

The question, put by Sen. Willis Smith (D., N. C.), was this: "Do you think it is within the province of the President to use some 'claim' inherent in the office to exhaust the power given him by statutory enactment?"

McGranery first insisted that the only answer he could give was that "no man would have the right to step outside the law." He protested that he was being asked for "checkbox opinions" on a historically unsettled constitutional question.

But when McCarran spoke out, McGranery said, "My answer is no."

He added, however, that his reply was subject to his earlier statement that no man is above the law.

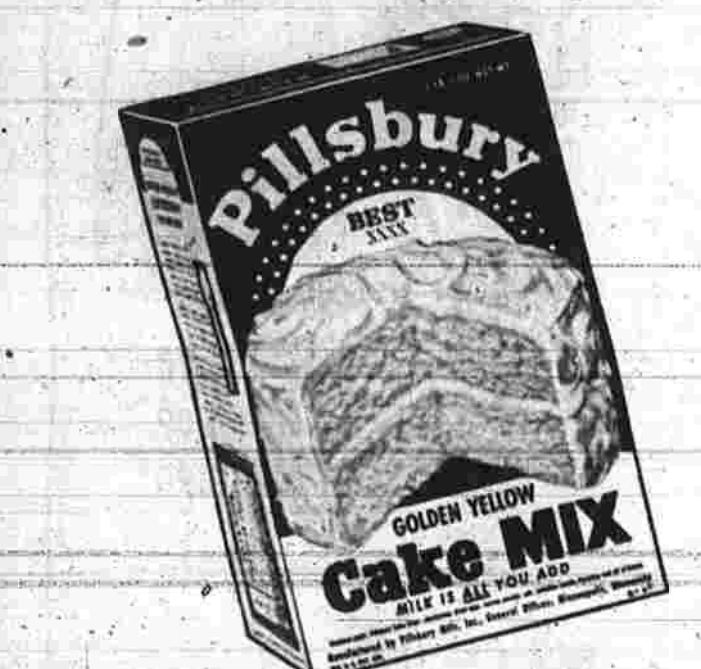

231, according to the AP poll before the Ohio returns. Tat's campaign leaders claim more delegates. They said he now has 404 delegates to 230 for the general election. Florida delegates were not counted yesterday. Another primary is set in that state for May 27, with both Russell and Kefauver expected to put on another campaign.

Russell gained most of his strength in the farm areas while Kefauver ran strongly in the cities. The Georgia Senator moved ahead shortly after midnight and counted to widen his margin, which was running about 3,000 votes ahead of Kefauver.

In the Ohio Republican race, Tat was opposed in 47 delegate contests by former Gov. Harold Bissell of Minnesota and in two by candidates announcing for Bissell. There was no popular vote contest and write-ins were not permitted.

Sweetest Prize

David S. Ingalls, Tat's campaign manager, said the "sweetest victory in Ohio" gives Tat "the most important prize of any of the primary contests held this far."

He said Tat has two-thirds of the delegates necessary for a first ballot victory at the convention after winning what he called "the sweetest of the year" in the largest solid block of delegates won so far in the Ohio results.

Mental Health Week is being observed this week throughout the state and an appeal for funds to further the study and care of mental patients is being conducted. A goal of \$75,000 is being sought by the Connecticut Association for Mental Health. Superintendent William F. Slover of Manchester Memorial Hospital is chairman of the local drive that is being conducted today by mail appeal. The local goal is \$2,000.

Letters were sent through the mail over the week end, Mr. Slover said, and the response is expected to begin by tomorrow. Contributions were being accepted by Robert Hathaway at the Manchester Trust Company. Many of the town's leading citizens, including doctors and physicians, are contributing to the fund. Mental health is not hereditary, authorities say, and more than 80 per cent of the patients are cured and returned to normal life in their communities. There are more than 8,000 cases in hospitals in the state now. This is the first public appeal for support the medical organization has ever made, functioning in the past only as a fraternal organization for mental health in the country, the parent of some 300 similar associations scattered over the nation.

Normal contributions will be the goal of \$25,000 reached quickly here, Mr. Slover is confident local residents will answer the appeal with mail contributions to the bank.
