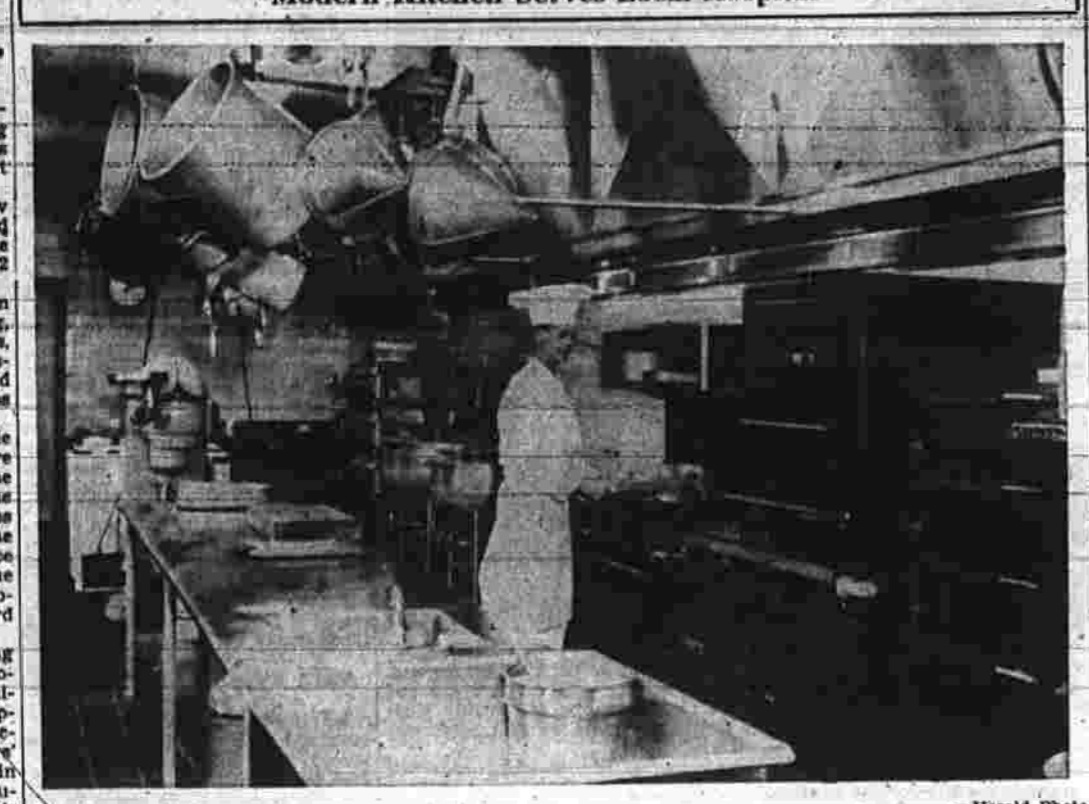

There are 218 full time employees serving the hospital and the community 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

### Dietary Unit Fully Modern

Miss Burr's Efficient Staff Can Serve 120 Meals in 35 Minutes

Visitors at MMH during opening this week end are going to be rightly proud of the new Dietary Department, located in the lobby, located to the north rear of the original building. Inside the story and a half brick house, 12 laundry dishes about a ton of laundry daily. Edmund Schubert is manager of the laundry. At 8 o'clock every morning the work begins in the laundry, where 1200 pieces of approximately 14,000 pounds of laundry each week. Mr. Schubert and his staff must do 180 uniforms that are pressed. Nursery linen is separated from the rest of the hospital laundry and processed alone. There are two washers, two extractors, two tumblers, one three-unit press and a 120 inch ironer. Chutes are emptied hourly.

The linen is washed for 30 minutes in 160 degrees, followed by four rinses in 140 degrees, two rinses at 120 degrees and one cold rinse, including blue water. Following the ironing, the linen from the chute is weighed and sorted. Iron work and rough dry laundry is washed separately. After the work is extracted, it is agitated, rough dry laundry goes through the tumblers at the rate of about 20 minutes per load. Once the iron or finishes, the linen is folded and delivered to the laundry.

Over the top of the laundry are six rooms providing living quarters for the employees. The job is being done at MMH under the able administration of Mr. Schubert.

### Hospital Staff Still Learning

Program is Designed to Keep All Informed of Medical Advances

Medical education is one of the most important parts of a hospital and has received much attention from the Manchester Memorial Association for many years. Programs are set up to instruct interns and externs at Manchester Memorial Hospital and keep the active staff informed on medical advancement.

Noon luncheons followed by scientific instruction meetings are held each Wednesday at the hospital. Dr. Howard Boyd is chairman of the Medical Education committee and Dr. Edward Besser is the acting director. Dr. Howard Lockwood is current chairman of the Wednesday noon luncheons.

All deaths and complications are discussed at these luncheons, are designed to fully acquaint the medical staff with hospital cases. Sound-track movies prepared by the Medical Association and other teaching institutions are selected and presented.

Recent programs have been on diseases of the liver. Dr. John Leonard, director of the Medical Association at Hartford Hospital, gave a pathological conference study on the subject during one of these gatherings.

Weekly department meetings, held and the doctors meet to discuss the outstanding problems of the week and service cases. A special effort is made to hold a month in the evening to hear a special speaker, selected from Manchester Memorial Hospital's department during the summer. In addition to the programs outlined above, special programs are arranged for them. Since the hospital has been approved for interns, the Board of Trustees has created an educational fund to be used for special courses given by members of Yale University faculty.

### Young Heart Clinic Is Growing Fast

Approved by the Board of Trustees, Manchester Memorial Hospital established a Heart Clinic on Nov. 28, 1951. Although only in operation a short time, the Heart Clinic was proven to be a most successful service offered for the welfare of the community. Five doctors, particularly interested and specially trained in cardiac disease, serve on the Heart Clinic and conduct the clinic.

Indigent heart patients are referred to the clinic for consultation and advice by family physicians. Recommendations are made by the clinic staff to the physicians.

The Heart Clinic is held on the last Wednesday of each month at 10:30 a. m. in the clinic rooms on the ground floor. There is no charge to patients for the service. The program is carried out on a purely voluntary basis by the doctors.

### 1951 Busy Year For X-Ray Staff

Also located in the west wing on the ground floor is the new X-ray Department that is staffed professionally by Dr. Douglas J. Roberts and his associates.

This department, with the improved facilities of the hospital, has expanded considerably from two to four diagnostic rooms. There are also two dressing rooms for out-patients and a dark room. Dr. Roberts hopes for further expansion of his department.

The remainder of the staff includes four technicians, an orderly and a secretary.

Last year 8427 X-rays were taken and there will be a marked increase in the work of this department this year. Dr. Roberts is looking to the future when it will be possible to open a Deep Therapy Room. The room is there at the moment, but is not equipped since no funds are available. The hospital is in hopes that public contributions will be forthcoming soon to give it a Deep Therapy Room to be proud of along with other advancements in the hospital's expanding program.

### Tumor Clinic 6 Years Old

Three Persons Attended First Session in 1946; 159 Cases at Present

One of the most active parts of Manchester Memorial Hospital is its "Tumor" Clinic, instituted in 1946. Dr. Edward Besser, who played an important part in the organization, has been medical secretary of the clinic since its start. Mrs. Jacqueline McLaughlin, RN, community director of the Manchester Branch of the Cancer Society, is the executive secretary of the Tumor Clinic, which is located in the lower lobby of the old building.

Support of the Tumor Clinic has been derived from funds procured each year during the Cancer drive. The Hospital Fund of Manchester has conducted drives to raise funds for the clinic and has taken an active part in its support. In addition, the Hair Dresser's Guild of this town raised funds to fully equip the clinic.

One of the main functions of the Tumor Clinic is to follow up cases from the time the tumor is diagnosed. The clinic works closely with the patient's physician through medical treatment. Meetings of the clinic are held twice a month at which time surgeons, radiologists and pathologists discuss case histories of patients and continue their knowledge for advancement.
