### Rockville Fail to Reach Any Decision During Fire District Session

Rockville, June 25—(Special)—The definite decision was reached last night as members of the Vernon Fire District zoning commission and the general public met in outdoor sessions at the Center Church. Due to the warmness of the evening, the meeting was carried to the side lawn.

Topic under consideration included the making of two new zones called A and B, and a trailer camp regulations. Under the two-zone plan, A would be a rural-residential area and B would encompass commercial-industrial properties. Vernon Center would fall into the former while under zone B certain land areas were designated. This would take a strip of land 200 feet deep on each side of Kelly road starting at the town line, east to the rotary, a strip of land 200 feet deep on each side of Route 20 starting at the rotary northeast to Phoenix street; a strip of land 200 feet deep on each side of Route 50 starting at Vernon scenic north to the boundary of the fire district; a strip of land 200 feet deep on each side of that part of Route 10 which lies in the Vernon Fire District Zone B. A list of all areas in the district contained in zone B will be raised at the meeting with the possibility (under the form of suggestion) that trailer occupants pay to the camp owner certain money which turns would be in the same category as property taxes. Nothing was decided on this matter. It was also brought out that under the new regulations now under study, establishment of trailer camps could not be allowed in

New Haven, June 25.—Yale University today announced it had received a March of Dimes grant of \$105,042 from the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis for research.

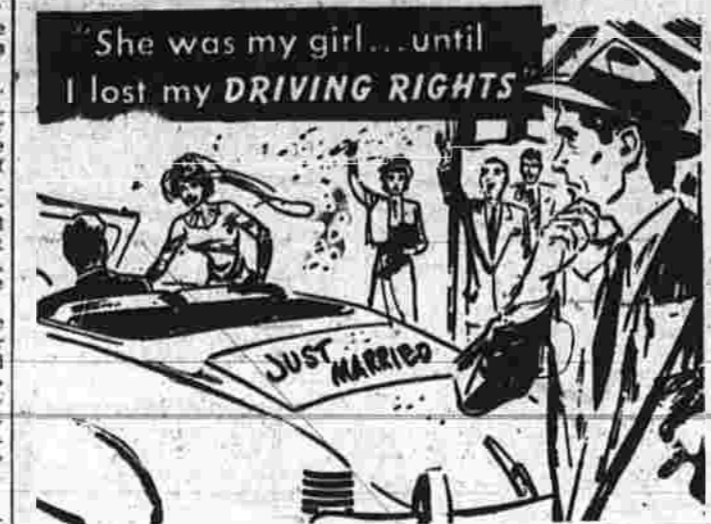

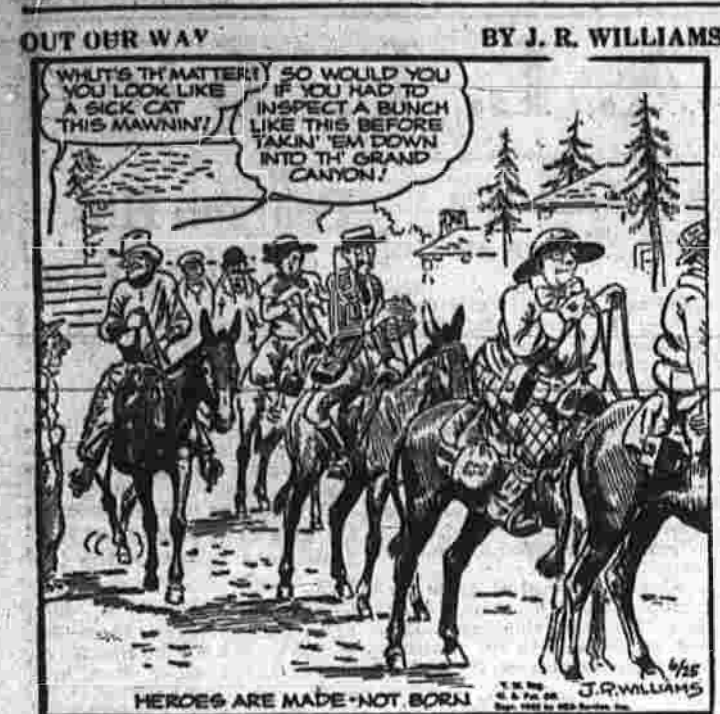
