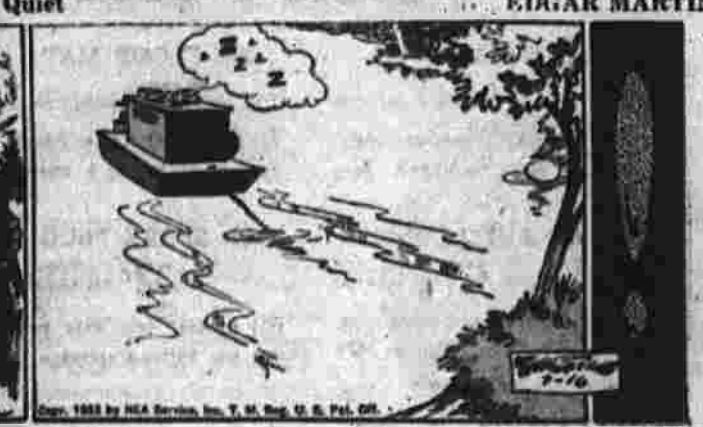
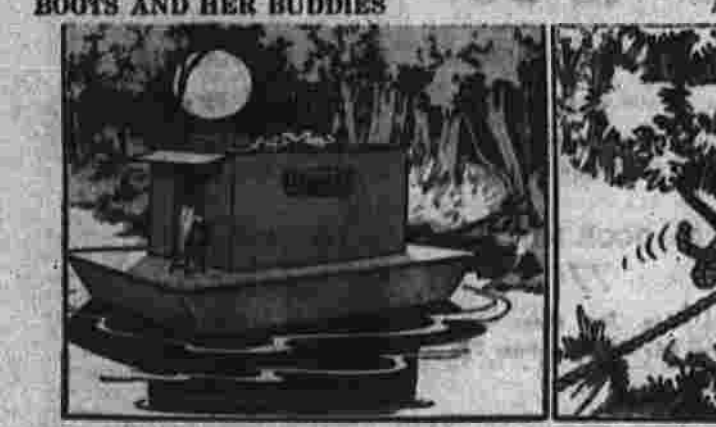

The union originally demanded union shop, making it compulsory for all employees to join the union.

panies calling for a modified union shop. This permits new employees to withdraw from the union between the 20th and 30th day of employment.

Murray blamed the breakdown in negotiations on the industry. In a statement that disclosed the wage-policy committee meeting, he said:

"I regret to state that the long pending steel dispute still remains unresolved."

The strike was forced upon the union by the industry. It continues because of an unwillingness to permit a fair settlement of the various issues in dispute.

"In accordance with the mandates of the union's international convention, I and my fellow officers have rejected the industry's fairly publicized last offer as inadequate."

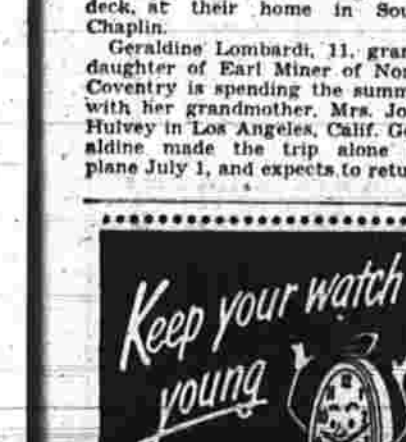

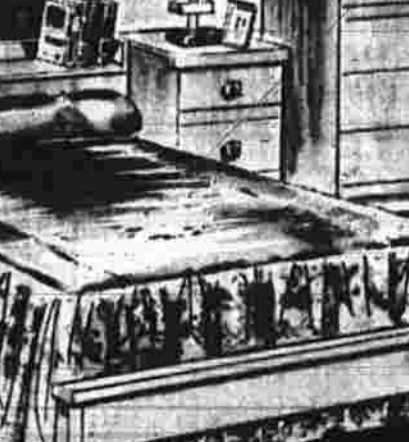

Likely To Draft Somebody
 Bitter-Republican experience has shown that the Democrats are potentially most dangerous when they recruit last. They were last four years ago, nominating a candidate who themselves did not want, a candidate whose name they had no real hope of winning. Yet, somehow, they got up off the convention floor and went on to win.

This year they are left again. They are heading towards Chicago in a quandary. They have no idea who their candidate will be. They have no easily available choice. They must choose. They are going to draft somebody, and that it will be one of two men, neither of whom wants to run.

If the convention had good luck, it would be Governor Adlai Stevenson of Illinois, who has already been discredited by his own record. He has incurred the displeasure of the White House because he was not sponsored by Truman for the nomination. He has incurred the displeasure of other party leaders because he will give them no definite commitment, which leaves them unwilling to risk their own influence and prestige on a choice which may turn them down in the end.

Despite these considerations, in circumstances the Democrats could find no one to exhibit some power in the convention. A draft may mean the attitude of the White House and of the party leaders, and Stevenson may be forced to accept, as a public duty, the nomination of another draft.

If this does not develop, the trend of the convention might lead to the nomination of another draft. There is only one man who might conceivably come close to solving the convention's problem. That man is Harry Truman. He has the opposition of the party, but he had it last time, and won. His current standing with the party and the people may not be high, but it is higher than it was at this time four years ago. He doesn't want to run, and the party doesn't want to nominate him, and that about everybody we think would prefer to see him yield to some new face. But, inevitably, if the one completely satisfactory new face in view will not have it, the convention will trend back toward the one other solution which would relieve it from making a choice from among a group of second-rate men who are not candidates.

They'll be due some extra money for the government pays interest of one half of one per cent each month on refunds not mailed by April 1, which is two weeks after the tax deadline.

Although refunds, like taxes themselves, are running higher this year, not as many people are getting them. Last year, 31 million people got refunds for 1950 tax overpayments; for 1948, there were a record 38,000,000.

Refunds were few and far between in 1949 because of the pay-as-you-go system of federal taxation through the withholding device was instituted in 1943. Now, more than half the 45 million people who file returns get a refund.

Mostly, people who overpay their taxes and that qualify for a refund are:

1. Those who get an extra dependent during the year—get married, have a baby or take on the support of another person.
2. Seasonal workers or full-time workers who have had their withholding taxes set to fit their income during the year.
3. Those who have had their income stop for part of a year—the striking steel workers, for instance—get overcharged.
