more than the lighting of a special kind of match. It is a healthy thing for us, and for our policy, at any rate, to have our minds jolted by such possibilities. For we still have a tendency, as a nation, and in our policy, to make the assumption that, somewhere along the line of progress, there must always be some stretch of monopoly for us. We started out with the naive assumption that we had developed monopoly on atomic bombs. We assumed that that monopoly made us a special nation, apart from all others, with special rights to police the world. And we made this monopoly the basis of our proposals for world atomic control. We were getting ready to perform our usual ritual, within a day or two, and what would, of course, have taken care of everything except in traditional Manchester fashion.

But now the news is that our tobacco raising neighbors are threatening to turn to atomic farming. We don't know how the forces of nature react to this news, but we know that, so far as we are concerned, we feel like an old Irish with doctor being confronted with some scientific interloper whose powerful crystals threaten our entire reputation and existence. If only, the thought comes to us, we could make it rain before the professional rainmakers have a chance to get their hands on the clouds, if only we can avoid the aerial demonstration of the power of the modern scientists, then we would still be the best writer in charge of this rain. So we speak the natural order of things as it is, not as it should be. Therefore, an unshelved complaint with our plea, to let the rain come in such a manner as to prove that the old Irish was not so good enough for Manchester.



Semi-Annual Values everywhere at Watkins!

It is a healthy thing for us, and for our policy, at any rate, to have our minds joined by such possibilities. For we still have a tendency, as a nation, and in our policy, to make the assumption that, somewhere along the trail of progress, there must always be some stretch of monopoly for us. We started out with the naive assumption that we had a monopoly on atomic bombs. We assumed that that monopoly made us a special nation, apart from all others, with special rights to police the world, solving problems for the monopoly of the atom. We assumed the basis of our proposals for world atomic control, including in those proposals our own right to produce our own monopoly and possession of bombs for as long as we ourselves saw fit.

Then Russia developed the bomb. We no longer had a monopoly, except for a time, as if, in many ways, in our thinking, in our military policy, and in our regard for world atomic control, we were the only nation of the modern scientists; then we looked as if we no longer had an absolute white-hand over the world.

We recovered from that period of doubt and uncertainty by announcing our own intention to proceed toward the making of the hydrogen bomb, many times more powerful than the atomic bomb. That became, in our imagination, and in our concept of national policy, the way to recover the monopoly power we thought we had with the simpler atomic bomb. Later, we discovered the hydrogen bomb, and we have been talking about making thousands of them, as the dread symbol of our monopolistic power.

This sort of dreaming, on our part, has been nothing more than a curse upon us. We are not dealing realistically with our own position in the world, and we are not dealing realistically with our own position in the world, and we are not dealing realistically with our own position in the world.

Whether or not this report from Italy is true, it is true that we can never be sure of any monopoly on any kind of mass destruction, weapons, from our headlines in Italy, proclaiming that this development has suddenly transformed Italy from a helpless power into a first-rate power. That may not be true now, but it is something that could happen for all we could do to stop it, and something that may happen if we persist ourselves in thinking that power can be raised, according to their possession of instruments of mass destruction.

We can see, of all us, just what will happen if Italy suddenly starts dispersing itself as a major force in the world just because it has developed a hydrogen bomb ahead of everybody else. We can see that it would be a curse upon Italy, leading it into its own destruction. We can see that some other nation would soon catch up, and how Italy's assumption of power would then prove to be a curse upon her.

What we have not quite been able to see, as yet, is that the same considerations really apply to us—that our atomic monopoly power in the field of destructive weapons is a purely artificial monopoly, which can be destroyed by the same forces which we use to create it. We use a diplomacy in which we may be out-powered at any surprise moment. Our concern with winning the atomic race is human and it is inevitable, but it does not lead toward safety of any kind. If we want safety, we shift our main concern toward the business of ending the race, not winning it.

The course before us is that we stop our treasure the illusion that we can win the race we never get any nearer about ending it. The news from Italy may not be true; but perhaps, for our own sanity, we ought to imagine that it is true.
