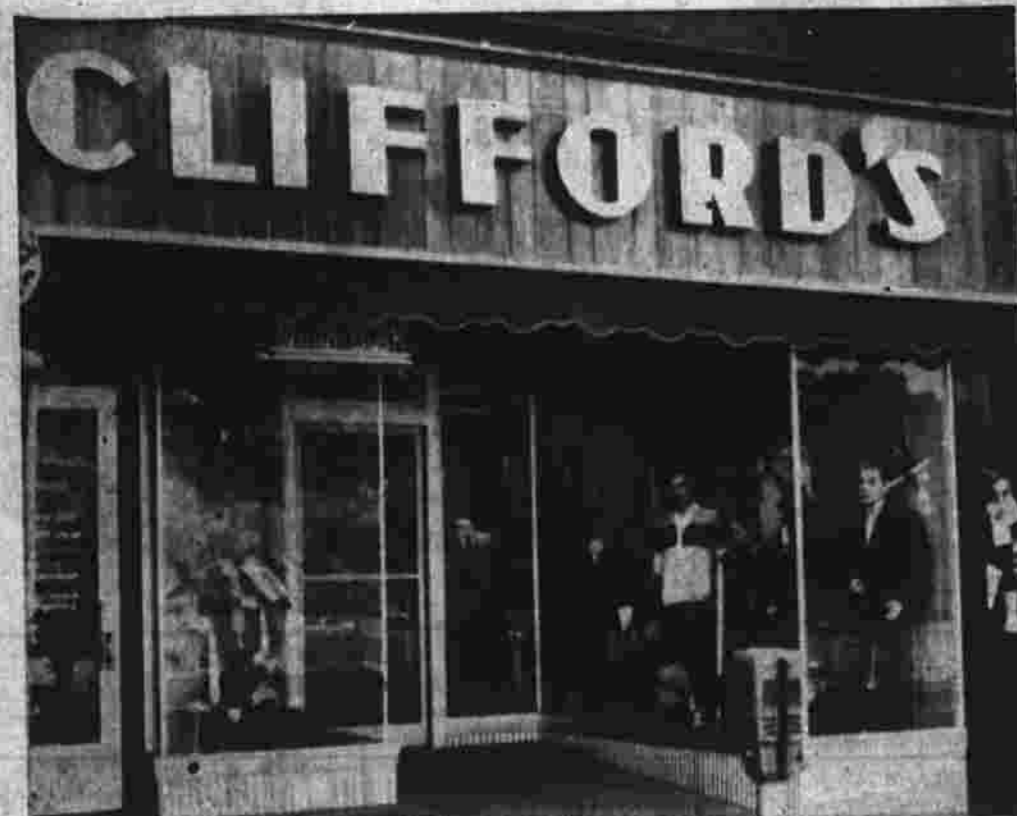

Screen Star Admits 'Stupid' Red Mix-up

Washington, Sept. 24.—(AP)—Stage and screen star Judy Holiday today told Senate investigators that in getting mixed up with various Communist fronts she was irresponsible and more than slightly stupid.

When she had her eyes opened to what was going on, she said, she herself hired people to investigate her.

Wesley Academy Award "I wanted to know what I had done," said the actress who won the motion picture Academy Award in 1951 for her portrayal of a dumb blonde in "Born Yesterday."

The Senate Internal Security subcommittee disclosed today that it had questioned Miss Holiday, comedian Sam Levenson, actor Philip Loeb and singer Burt Ives.

The testimony of all four was made public. It showed that they all were asked about Communist front organizations or activities with which their names have been linked.

Levenson and Ives appeared before the subcommittee at their own request.

The Senate group has been looking for any subversive infiltration of the radio, television and entertainment industries.

Today's second volume of testimony was given by Miss Holiday.

In an accompanying statement, however, Chairman McCarthy (R-Nev.) said that "Communism stands itself as a leech" on the

careers of prominent figures in the entertainment world.

He remarked on what he called an striking number of Communist-front organizations and Communist-sponsored activities in which some of the witnesses have been involved.

"We do not want to accuse anyone of guilt by association," McCarthy said, "but it is a dangerous type of thinking that leads people into such involvements."

"It is not the sort of thinking that should be permitted to express itself freely in such important media as radio, television and motion pictures," he said.

Miss Holiday, who was born in 1921, testified that in 1948 she was hired by Henry A. Wallace for two hours and 40 minutes at a secret hearing here last March 28.

She said she had let her name be used by Communist-front organizations without knowing what they were.

"I have answered to a realization that I have been irresponsible and slightly more than slightly stupid," she said.

She said she had never knowingly taken part in any Communist movement.
