An up-to-date police manual containing regulations concerning promotions, recruiting of personnel, pre-service and in-service training and discipline emerged yesterday as the Board of Directors answered to the problem of how to handle the situation in the Manchester Police Department.

At an extraordinary session of the board yesterday afternoon in the hearing room of the Municipal Building, members voted unanimously to direct General Manager Richard Martin to prepare such a manual with the assistance of Police Chief Herman S. Schendel.

The resolution was contained in a carefully worded and prepared resolution which set forth the board's attitude toward the police department's problem. It was passed by a vote of 10 to 0.

Yesterday was the third day in succession the board met on the question of what Mayor Harold E. Dunkin has termed "the police department's problem."

Monday evening the directors questioned Schendel as to the progress of the manual. He reported that the manual is now being prepared.
