Artificial Kidneys Saving UN Soldiers

With U. S. Eighth Army, Korea, Nov. 12-1952. The artificial kidney, a revolutionary medical device long in development, has saved the lives of many wounded allied troops.

Medical authorities say the apparatus, which does the work of the human kidneys when wounds or illness prevent those organs from functioning properly, prevents the spread of deadly urinary poisoning.

Uremic poisoning results from the kidneys' failure to discharge body wastes from the blood stream. Treatments last approximately

six hours. After that the patient's own kidneys are usually functioning properly. If not, the treatment is repeated.

The machine was first used in Korea, Feb. 14 at St. Mary's Episcopal Church.

Rockville, Nov. 12.—(Special)—Tech. Sgt. Anthony J. Iwanicki of Rockville has been awarded the Silver Star for gallantry in action while serving with the First Marine Division in Korea. Major General J. T. Bolton authorized the citation.

Iwanicki has been cited for "outstanding courage, aggressiveness and coolness under fire," while his company was engaged in attacking a fanatically defended enemy hill position on July 6, 1952.

His platoon moved through the lead group pushed down by enemy fire. Partially blinded by a painful facial wound, Sgt. Iwanicki refused evacuation and continued to reorganize his unit which was being overrun by the enemy. He helped the wounded, the report stated, and the set-up fire-power concentrated on enemy trenches.

He moved from man to man along the lines in disregard for enemy cross-fire and his own safety; offering encouragement and directing the attack on the enemy position. It was not until orders were received to break contact with the enemy that Iwanicki was evacuated to a medical station for treatment.

Born and raised in this community, Iwanicki is 27 years old and has been in the Marines since 1941 when he enlisted. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. John Iwanicki of River street. He attended and graduated from St. Joseph's and Rockville High Schools. During World War II, he served with the Marine in the Pacific theater for 18 months. Lend-Lease Ships Will Go to Japan

Tokyo, Nov. 12.—(Special)—The U. S. and Japan today signed an agreement under which American ships will be lent-lease to Japan to bolster this nation's security forces.

U. S. Ambassador Robert D. Murphy and Japan's Foreign Minister Kato-Daikihei signed the agreement in the Japanese capital.

Under the agreement, the U. S. will lend-lease not more than 16 patrol frigates and 30 landing craft for five years without charge. The term can be extended for another five years if requested.

The agreement takes effect when both governments exchange notes on the completion of certain legal steps.

The U. S. Congress last July approved a bill authorizing the President to lend the ships.

Hiss becomes eligible for parole on Nov. 21 when he will have completed one-third of his term at the Northeastern Federal Penitentiary.

Dr. George G. Killinger, chairman of the U. S. Parole Board, today began interviews of prisoners applying for parole. He said, however, there was no chance of reaching Hiss' case today.

"I will interview Hiss personally by tomorrow or Friday," Killinger told a newsmen.

Killinger said transcripts of all parole interviews will be sent to Washington for consideration by the full five-member board.

It takes about two weeks for our transcripts to reach Washington.
