Nine Blasts, 'No School'
Illing Notifies Parents Of Signals To Be Used If Closing Is Necessary

With winter weather expected to break soon, Superintendent of Schools Arthur H. Illing has announced the method that will be used in notifying parents of the closing of schools for the day.

In a notice sent home to parents, he tells them that, in the event schools have to be closed for the day, a "no school" signal of nine blasts will be given by both the Manchester Fire Department and the South Manchester Fire Department at 7:30 a. m.

Also, radio stations WDRG and WYIC will make announcements on programs between 7 and 8 p. m. Conversely, the absence of signals will mean that schools will have regular sessions.

In his notice, Illing indicates that schools will not be closed unless it is deemed absolutely essential by school authorities. He says that state law requires the schools to operate 180 days in the school year, and "our calendar gives but little leeway in this matter."

Illing also states in his notice that regardless of whether schools have had to be called off on any day because of the weather, the school buildings will be open Tuesday night, Nov. 18, at the business meeting, any children who their signals crossed and trouble in school through winter weather only to find themselves without school or other gift items to bring the younger members of the family.

In addition to the customary display at Mary Cheney Library, the West side branch and Whitton Memorial Library, the children's librarians have Book Week at the various schools where library service is extended by the local librarians.
