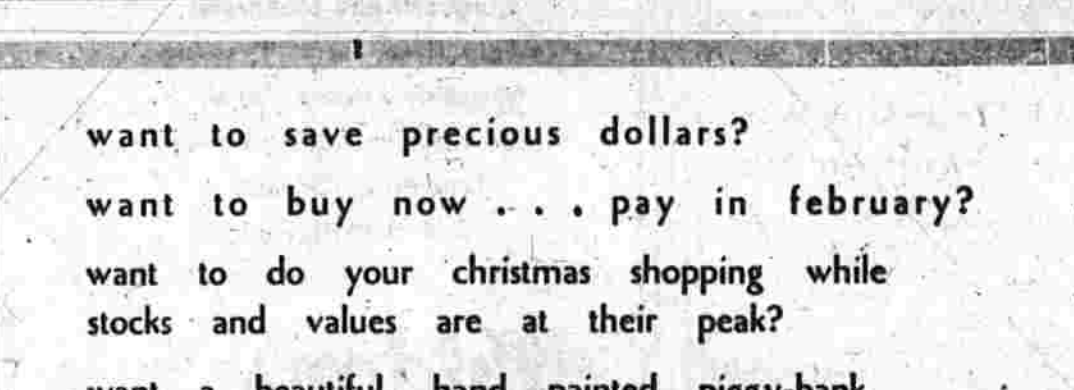

Eye Comfort and TELEVISION Eye comfort depends on the relation of screen brightness to general room lighting. Here are some suggestions that may improve your eye comfort while watching television:

1 Operate Set Correctly: For a minimum of glare be sure to set contrast and brightness controls correctly. If the screen "glares" at you, you need additional room lighting.

2 Balance Lighting: Turn on all floor and table lamps to about 100 watts.

3 Reflected Glare: Move a small mirror over the screen of your set. If you can see the reflection of a lamp from any viewing position, you have reflected glare. Correct by moving set or lamp, or turn off the lamp.

4 Back Lighting: Place a 40-watt light behind set to light the wall behind it. This will reduce contrast.

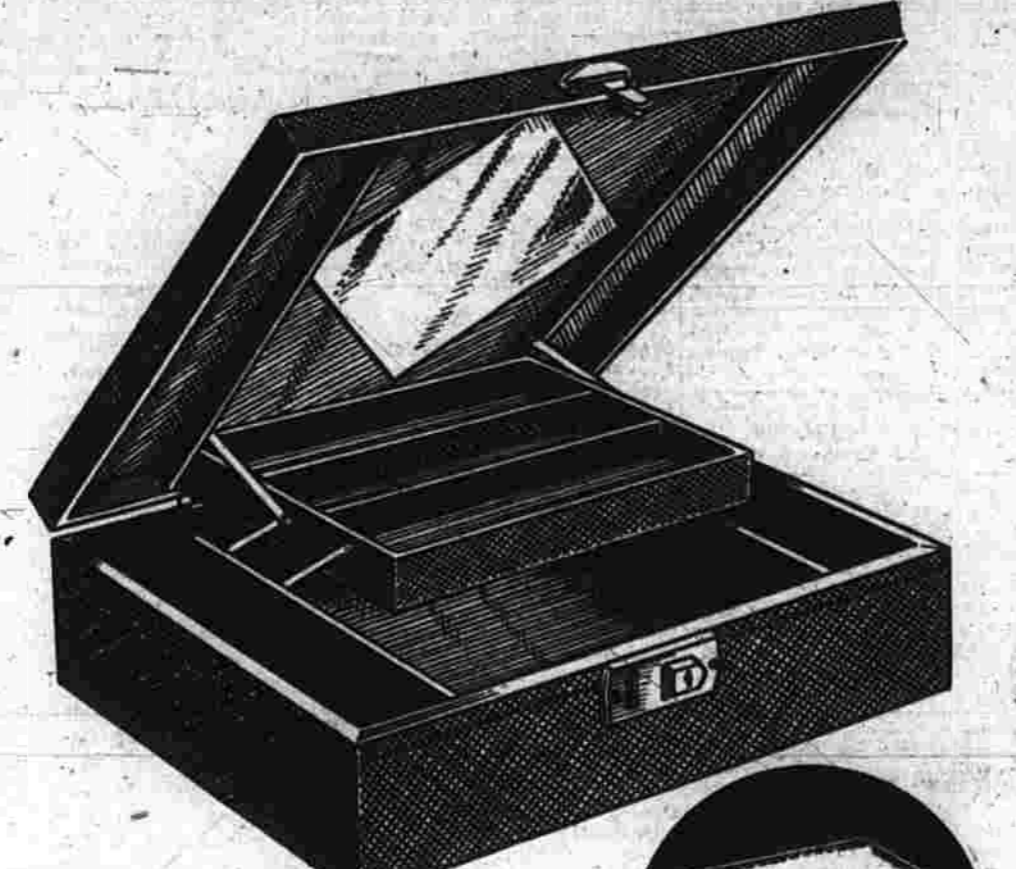
