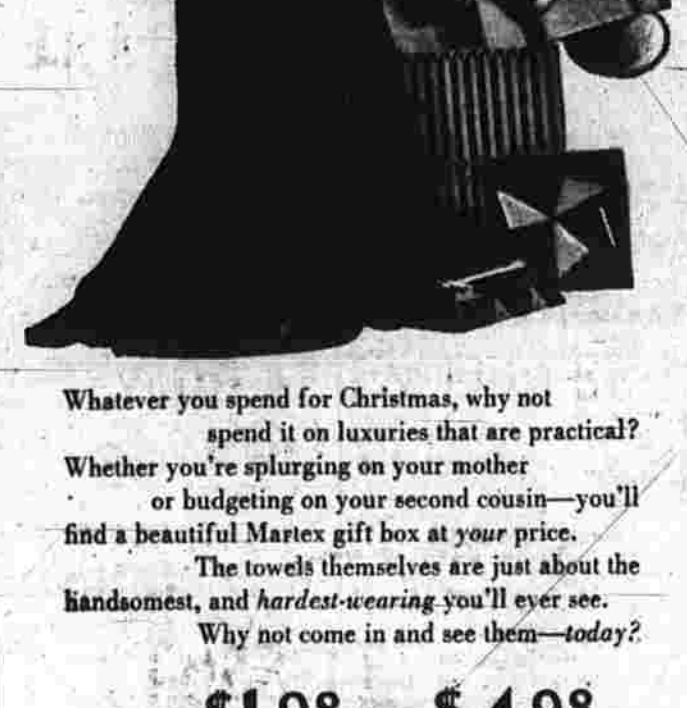

Hebron 'White Sunday' Holiday Cheer Meeting Slated

Hebron, Dec. 3—(Special)—"White Sunday" will be observed at Hebron and Gilead Congregational Churches Dec. 14. This is an annual custom to provide Christmas cheer for students of the town, hospital patients and elderly people.

Members and Sunday school children are asked to bring in gifts suitable for the occasion, wrapped in white paper. Gifts may include such articles as candy, tobacco, fruit, handkerchiefs, notepaper, or anything appropriate. The gifts will be collected and placed in a "merry" prepared for their reception.

Miami, Fla., Dec. 3—(AP)—Eastern Air Lines resumed some Constellation flights today and told striking flight engineers to return to work by 2 p. m. or lose their jobs.

EAL officials said a super Constellation took off from Miami International Airport at 8:30 a. m., manned by a flight engineer supervisor.

Similar planes were scheduled to leave New York for Miami at 10 a. m. and 2 p. m. with flight engineer supervisors as regular crew members.

EAL's Constellation fleet was grounded at 8 p. m. Monday when flight engineers struck for higher wages after several weeks of negotiations for a new contract.

The contract with the flight Engineers International Association (AFL), expired at midnight Nov. 30. Some airports were picketed and service at a dozen major points east of the Mississippi was affected.

Lodge To The UN

It is to be hoped that, in naming an individual as close and important to his own political career as the United Nations, the city's official permanent representative to the United Nations, President-elect Eisenhower intended to give new emphasis to the importance of this nation's relationship to the UN.

Under the Truman administration, the post which Lodge will now fill has not been of front rank importance, even though it has been filled only enough by former Senator Warren Austin, the Vermont Republican. The decline of importance for the post seems to be present, it has, we would judge, come about through the fact that Truman-Acheson policy has known how to deal with the United Nations, ignoring it most of the time and then suddenly, on special occasions, considering it indispensable. When it has been indispensable, Acheson has moved in personally.

Meanwhile, the thing which should have been happening has not been happening. That, should be a steady, level accentuation of this nation's loyalty to the United Nations principle, and of its willingness to comply with United Nations ideals and procedures, and it should reflect the truth, which is that the United Nations is the one and only hope for peace there is in our world.

In what should be, the post of American representative to the United Nations should be the greatest ambassadorial post in our world, and a post of importance secondary only to that of the President himself. We hope that President-elect Eisenhower's chief of state should have the earnest desire to emphasize the importance in which his whole administration will hold the United Nations.

USAF and Navy in the air, Lovett said.

1. He happened to differ with Gilpatrick's views.

2. Yes, there probably is some point at which some duplication is reached but the more methods there are of delivering explosives on a larger the better off we are.

3. The thing to do is to give the services what they reasonably need for a reasonable function.

Then, alluding to the usual rivalry of budget-making periods, Lovett commended Gilpatrick's remarks that this was about the kind of thing you could look for annually and at about this time.

In connection with his inclusion of requests for money for letting the Navy start work on a big ship carrier, Lovett explained that it was only part of a fund, that usually no single appropriation bill contained all the money for a big ship.

He did not specify amounts, but the Forrestal class carriers are expected to total more than 218 million dollars each, without their planes armament.

Reporters wanted to know if the Joint Chiefs of Staff (The Chiefs of the Army, Navy and Air Force, with Gen. Omar Bradley as chairman of the three-man group) had "approved" building of a third carrier.

Lovett's answer was that the Unification Act under which the JCS is set up contains no requirement that the chiefs approve a project, only that they advise the Secretary. He emphasized that the chiefs group makes no decisions, but provide only advice. He said he always consults them for advice.

The questioners later decided that they didn't know what the Joint Chiefs, individually or collectively, thought about the new carrier.

debate of true negotiations which has been underway in the UN, which are not apparently involved in Eisenhower's trip to the west zone. It is felt here that it is of considerable importance for Dulles to understand this situation as completely and quickly as possible.

2. **India-China:** This war area is of immediate concern to the United States. The French are carrying the burden of resistance to Communist aggression there now, and evidence of Russian military supplies being shipped in was reported. Eisenhower's trip to a drain on French resources and the Paris government in the past has treated for greater American assistance because of it.

3. **Iran:** A crisis is believed to be coming up in Iran, where State Department officials have long been concerned about the danger of a Communist takeover. Economic conditions grow steadily worse due to the long-standing war between Iran and Britain over oil nationalization, which has cut off Iran's major source of revenue from the sale of oil. American officials are working to solve this problem.

4. **Berlin:** This is regarded by authorities here as a constantly danger spot, and there has recently been an increase of concern because proposals for the treatment of western Germany are due soon to come to a climax in the West German and French parliaments.

5. **France:** West German rearmament has caused an increase of political tension in France, which also has shown deep resentment of United Nations intervention in the self-government.

6. **Latin America:** Some concern is beginning to be expressed here over the trend of political developments in Latin America, where diplomats report a growing nationalism which in some countries takes an anti-United States line.

President Truman and Secretary of State Acheson agreed several weeks ago when they met here that there was no question of having the new administration share responsibility for the decisions of the old. However, Truman officials have been hopeful that Dulles would be willing to consult with them on any important decisions which might have to be made prior to Jan. 20.

Dulles was asked whether he plans to go to Paris next week for a meeting of the North Atlantic Treaty Council Dec. 15. He said that had not been discussed.

Hal Boyle Bosses Have Ruined The Coffee Hour

New York—(AP)—In most American business offices there comes a pause in the day's occupation that is known as "The Coffee Hour."

In fact there usually are two pauses—one in the morning, the other in the afternoon.

It has grown so insistently that it is now a generally accepted fact of office life, and is taken as a normal working condition. Most employers now put up with it. They have come to realize that groups, like children, have to have a periodic recess to let off their pent-up nervous energy.

Fifteen to 25 years ago the following ominous notice was a common sight on company bulletin boards:

"It has come to the management's attention that a number of employees are leaving their desks during their hours of employment to get coffee. This will not be tolerated and must cease at once."

That, of course, was a flat dare, and a challenge. An employee would spend an hour every morning figuring a new way to sneak down the back stairs, gulp a quick cup of coffee, and be back before he was missed. He felt like a naughty child disobeying his parents, and always wondered the reason for it.

"If I bump into the Boss, will he fire me?"

Oh, the coffee hour was a fine thing in those days. If you met another employee doing the same thing, you both had a secret to share: You were putting something over on the Boss. Everyone on the payroll became linked in a partnership of conspiracy. You all were getting away with something forbidden.

Gradually the practice became so widespread that the management came to realize the rule against it was an unnecessary one. The prohibition law. So they quit putting up the notices.

Many went even further. Following the British custom, they started trundling little coffee and soft drink carts about twice a day so that the employees could have an interlude of gossip and refreshment at their desks. This is now commonplace in many firms, and this compromise gives the employer one big advantage: He at least knows where the employees are.

Today the coffee hour is an accepted institution. It has infatuated the bosses themselves. They decided, "Well, if all the hired hands are going downstairs to get a cup of coffee, I might as well, too. I could use a little myself."

So what happens? You are sitting there enjoying a cup of steaming brew, contentedly aware that
