### Quick to Fix Rice and Crabmeat Casserole

All the "fret" (your family) will be in and on time for the meal if they are given notice that this scrumptious Rice and Crabmeat Casserole is coming from the "kitchen." This saucy rice treat won first place honors in the rice and fish division of the Crows Cookery Contest at the 1932 International Rice Festival. It is really good!

The odds of melt-in-the-mouth taste, from stem to stern, in this prize winning rice dish are terrific enough to cause King Neptune himself to tuck a napkin under his chin and pick up a fork.

**Ingredients:**

- 1 cup butter or margarine
- 2 cups milk
- 1 cup crabmeat
- 1 cup cooked rice
- 1 hard cooked egg, chopped
- 1/2 cup finely chopped onion
- 1/2 cup finely chopped parsley
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 cup bread or cracker crumbs

**Preparation:** The Fluffy White Rice: To make 3 liberal cups of fluffy rice, put 1 cup of uncooked rice, 2 cups of cold water and 1 teaspoon of salt into a 2 quart saucepan and bring to a vigorous boil. Turn the heat as low as possible. Cover saucepan with a lid and leave over the hot heat for 14 minutes. Turn off the heat. Do not remove lid nor stir rice while it is cooking. After rice has cooked, remove saucepan from heat—but keep the lid on until rice actually is served.

Use exact measurements of uncooked rice and water. Time the cooking accurately.

For real convenience and economy of time and effort, keep uncooked rice in the refrigerator in a covered container at all times. Use it for many quick, delicious and inexpensive soups, salads, casserole dishes, hot breads and desserts.

**Method:** Melt butter or margarine in a saucepan. Add the flour and blend thoroughly. Gradually add the milk and continue stirring until the mixture thickens. Add the crabmeat, rice, eggs, onions, parsley, salt and pepper to this sauce. Mix thoroughly. Place in a greased casserole. Cover with the crumbs. Bake in a 350 degree F. oven for 30 minutes.

The vote was taken after a long and heated debate. The French and British delegations were the main opponents of the proposal.
