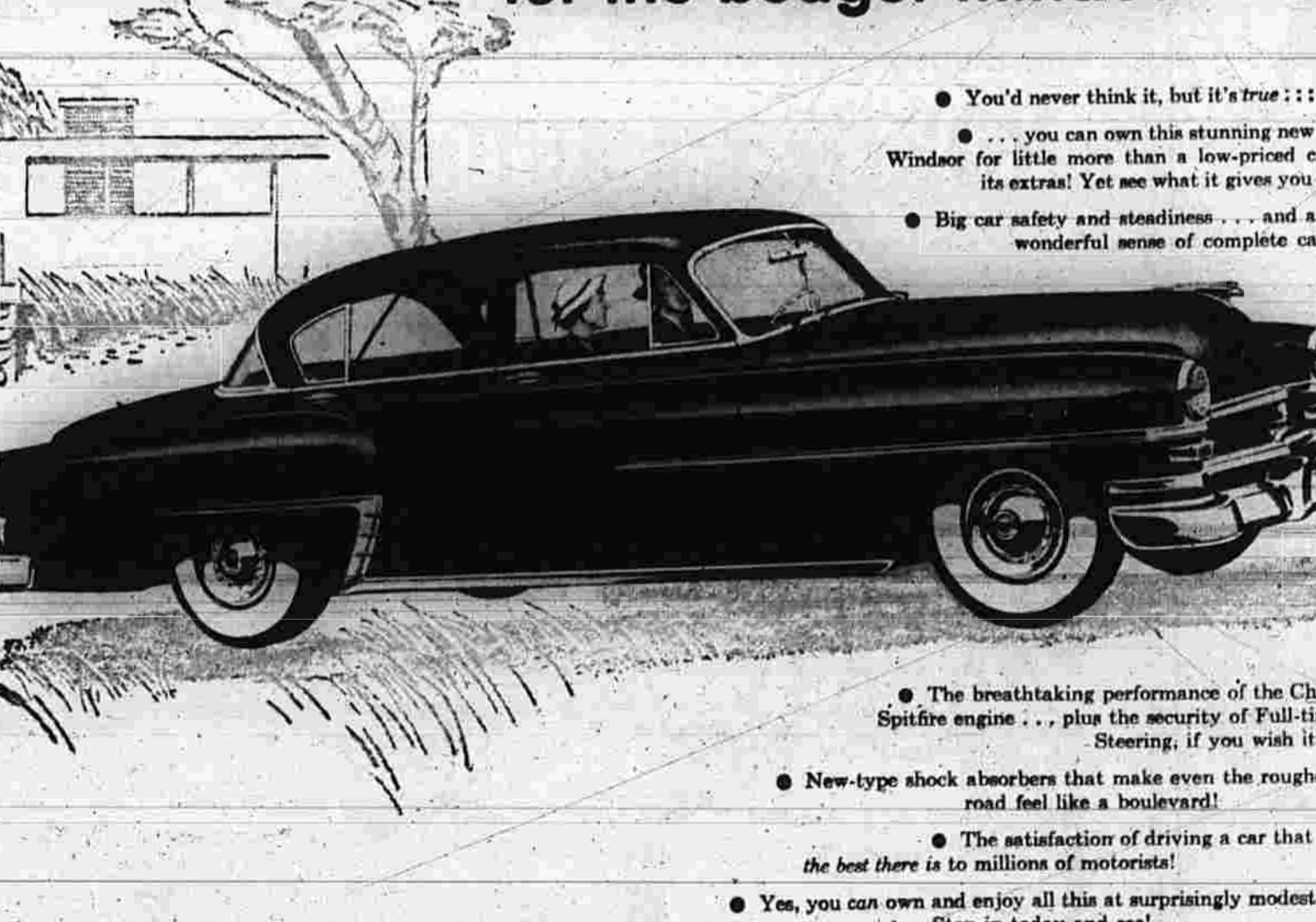

Col. R. E. Gates
Passes at 56
 Rocky Hill, Jan. 25.—Col. Raymond P. Gates, 56, long active in Republican party and veterans affairs, died yesterday at Rocky Hill veterans home and hospital where he had been commandant since 1940.
 Gates, in poor health for a number of years, was stricken Friday. The cause of death was not immediately known.
 Earlier last week he had gone to Washington with the First Company, Governor's Foot Guard, of which he was major commandant. He had witnessed the parade from a reviewing stand with Gov. John Lodge and other dignitaries.
 A veteran of World War I, Gates had long been active in the affairs of the American Legion, both nationally and in the state. He served as its National Vice Commander in 1928, and was on its national executive and legislative committees at the time of his death. He also was department legislative chairman.
 Gates was a native of Wallingford, Conn., where he was born in 1897, and was commissioned a second lieutenant in the Ordnance department in October of the following year. Transferred to Camp Lewis, Wash., he served 2½ years until his discharge in April, 1919.
 He entered the 43d National Guard division in 1925 as a first lieutenant, serving a colonel in 1940. Two years later he was appointed major commandant of the First Company, Governor's Foot Guard, while serving as property officer for the Governor's Foot Guard, a post he held from 1940 to 1946.
 Gates was commandant of the Pitch home for soldiers at Norton Heights for five years before being assigned to command the new State Home and Hospital for Veterans here.

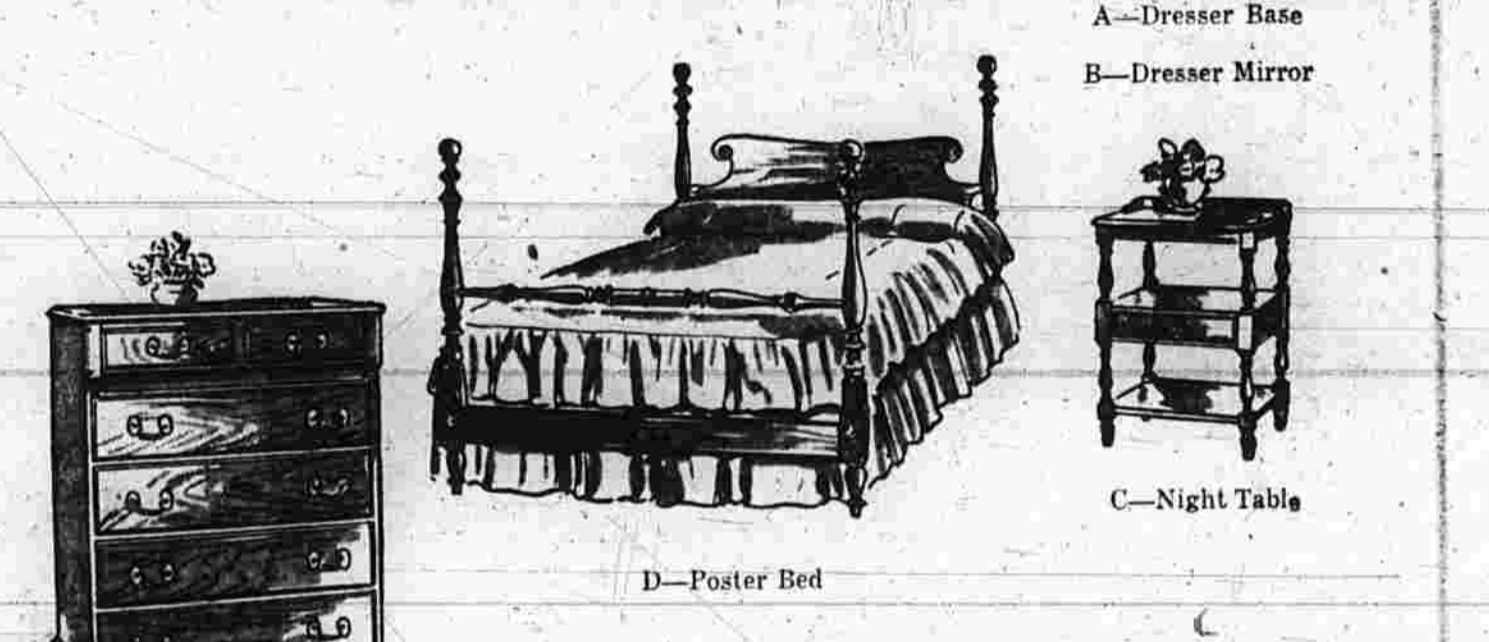
White Bread Again
 Baked for the first time in 12 years, the people of Britain will be able to buy white bread.
 The Churchill government has ordered the decontrol of bread. That means bakers can put into a loaf of bread whatever they please in put into it, and change whatever price they please for it.
 Under the system which is now in effect, a system which has, of course, done much to help Britain through the tight economic squeeze of the post-war years, both the content and the price of the bread has been regulated to make the bread a very healthy, nutritious non-white. The price has been regulated with the help of a government subsidy, at eight cents a loaf. It was a very tasty loaf, very cheap.
 It was such a good loaf, at such a good price, in fact, that not even the Churchill government dared do away with it, entirely. The bakers of Britain are to be compelled to keep on producing it, and they are to keep getting a government subsidy which will enable them to sell it for the old price. The new white loaf, when it appears, is expected to sell for about 11 cents.
 Even the Churchill government is afraid that the return to "free enterprise" might lead to higher prices and then demands for higher wages all the way through the nation, throwing Britain off its feet. Whatever advantages the Communists may have derived from our failure to attack across the Yalu, there have been great advantages for us in the fact that we have never had to defend ourselves against Communist bombing.

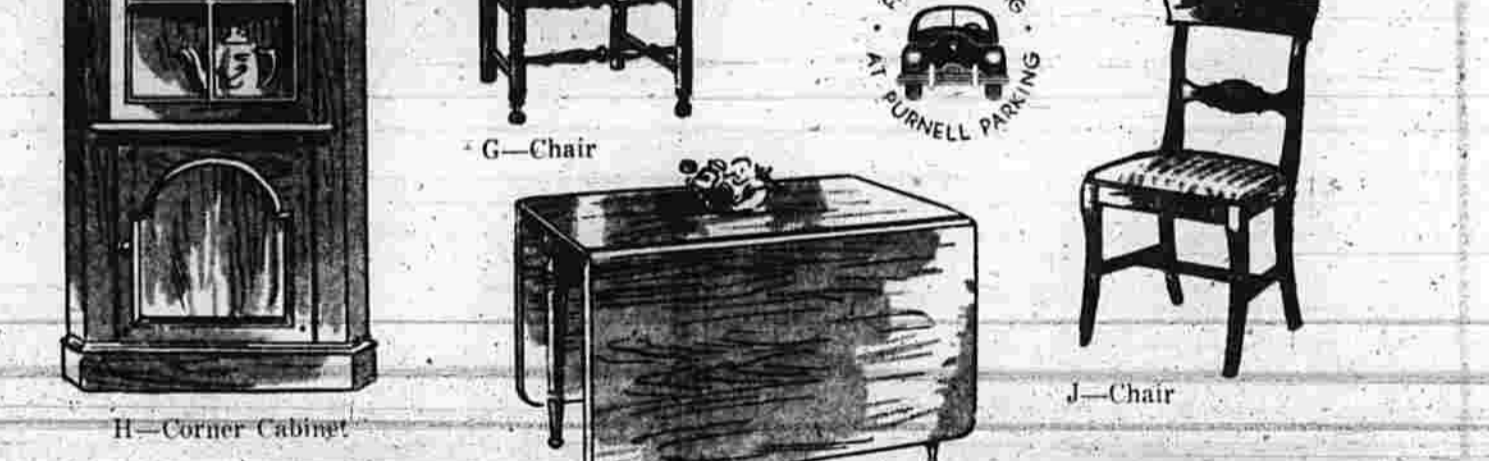

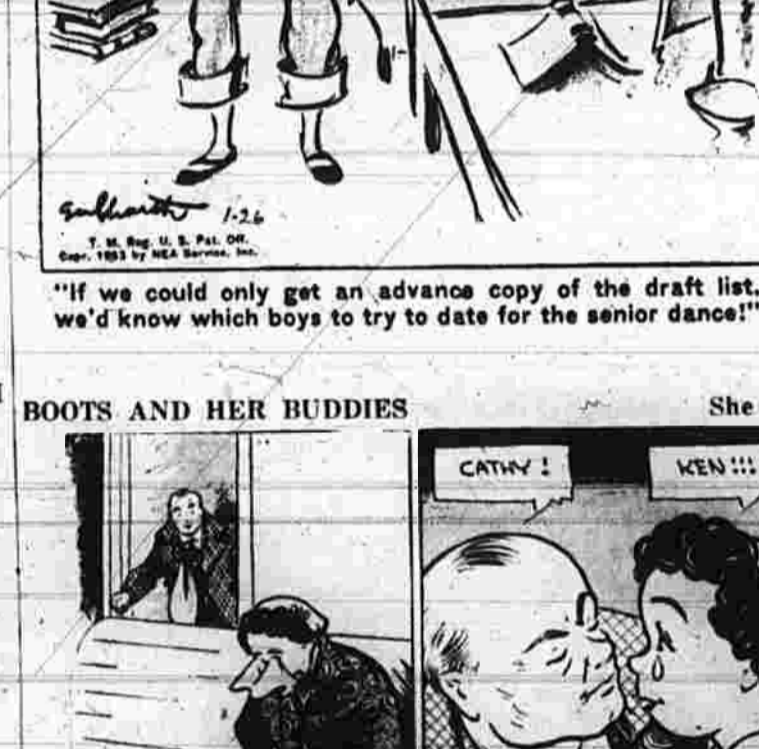

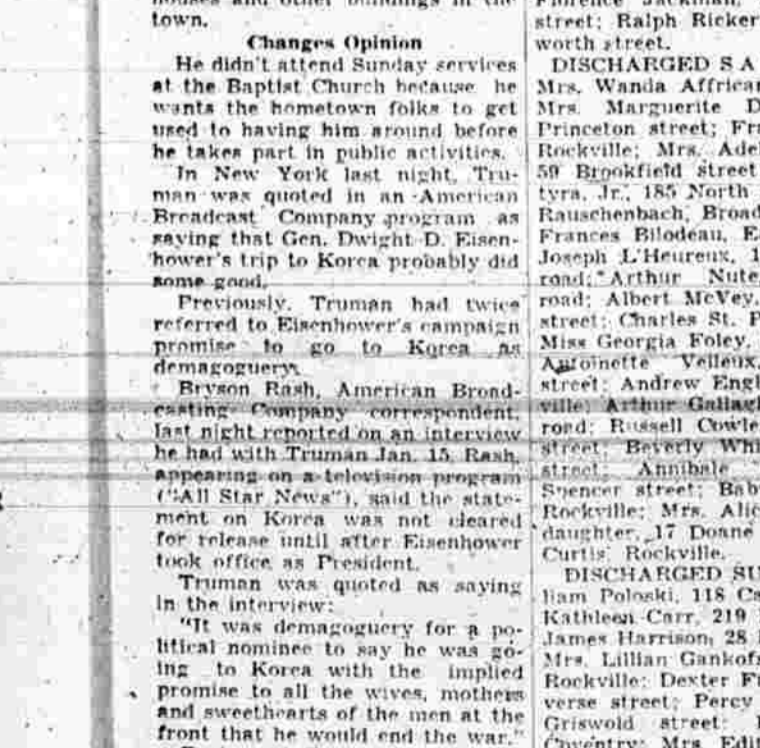
