### Over 40, Need a Job? Check on Personality

ADALDAE REER, AP Newsfeatures Writer, New York, Feb. 20.—Any body over 40 looking for a job had better take stock of himself to make sure he is not his own biggest stumbling block.

The survey was made by a "personality" firm, such as talking too much and a lack of adaptability, may be the greater handicap than any prejudice against the older worker.

The cost of his pension and group insurance—so often cited as blinks to the older worker's employment.

That is the conclusion of 80 private employment agencies of the New York City, as revealed in an exhaustive survey of the job-hunting problems and performance of men and women over 40.

The survey was made by the New York State Joint Legislative committee on problems of the aging as part of many years' effort to aid the 40-plus jobseeker in his quest for work.

The survey was conducted by a committee headed by Senator Thomas Diamond of Newburgh.

Against the jobseeker over 40 spots his own chances of getting a job," said Sen. Diamond. "Too often this is the picture he presents:

"He talks too much. He interrupts the man who is considering him. He drags out or drags on the chair with his fingers. In other words he shows a lack of poise. He shows he has become a victim of ways and in his opinions and lacks firmness to adapt himself to new conditions.

"In short, he shows that he is going no thought to the boss's needs and has no interest in them. He is interested only in his own. All things considered, he presents a personality he would not hire himself."

If the tables were reversed, Of course he is not aware of what he is doing. But nevertheless, in just these things, he often blocks his own progress."

Sen. Diamond said the survey indicated that women are a bigger problem than men in 40-plus job placements — largely because of their own attitudes.

"There is the woman who makes a martyr of herself because she has to take a job at her age and will gladly take anything," he said.

"There is the over-age flirt who goes job-hunting wearing too much makeup and too elaborate clothes. There is the one who says too much. I've never done that before," she objects to accommodating an employer in such small things as switchboard relief, office reception or information service.

"When there is the applicant who feels that the way she has been taught to do a job is the only way. Instead of trying to fit herself to the job, she tries to reorganize it to meet her standards. Finally there is the applicant who resents giving any information about herself because she thinks the interviewer is prying into her personal affairs."

The agencies urged that communities do more to aid the older worker in his job quest — including helping him to see himself as he is and correct the faults that block his progress. Among their suggestions were public counseling centers, training, and restraining centers and 40-plus clubs.

### In Civil Defense Blind May Help

New York.—(AP)—General headquarters of the U. S. Air Force has agreed that blind persons can have a very definite role in the ground observer corps in civil defense, says the American Foundation for the Blind.

Blind persons can perform telephone duties at observation posts and identify aircraft by sound in cases where visual contact cannot be made with approaching aircraft, due to inclement weather conditions. They may also be used as raid clerks and recorders at filter centers, the announcement says.

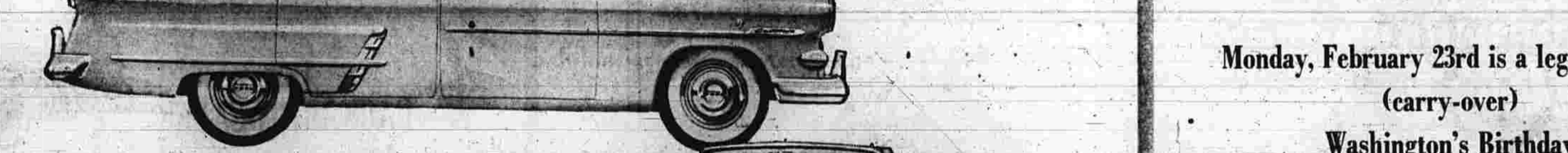

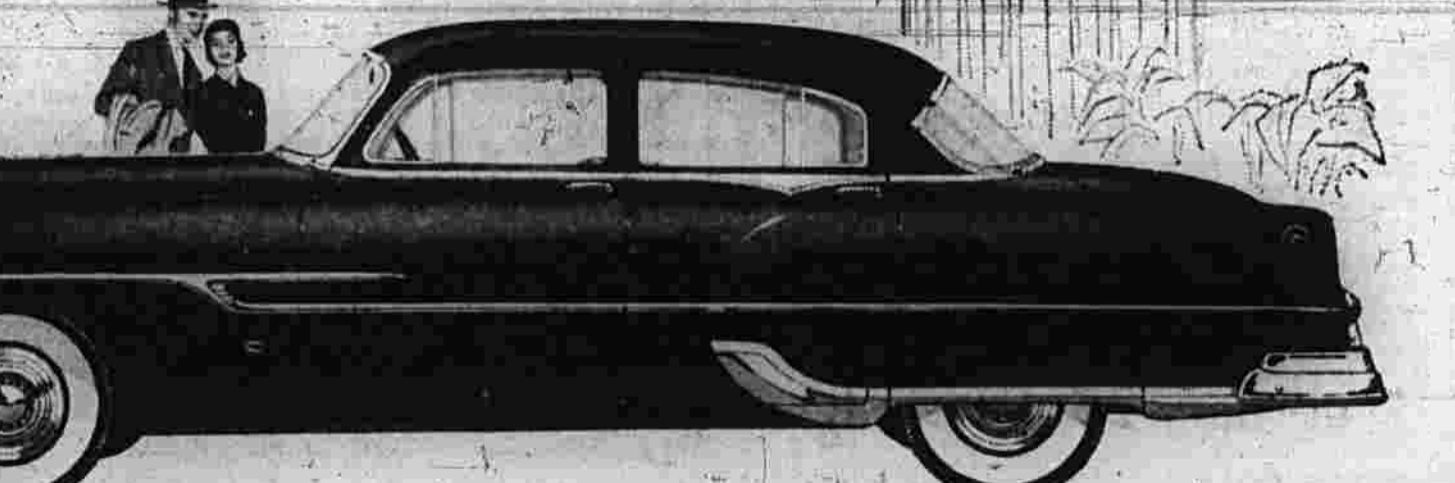

But he continued in a statement yesterday that Mrs. Meyer, in a speech which precipitated a row between them, hoped to coerce the committee into calling off its investigation of the field of education.

Mrs. Meyer, wife of Eugene Meyer, board chairman of the Washington Post, criticized Velde and plans for proposed legislation to close down U. S. schools in Atlantic City, N. J.

Velde had quoted Mrs. Meyer as writing to the Journal "New Frontiers" a letter expressing "profound admiration for the people of the Soviet Union."

Velde said yesterday he acted on information given him by an accurate source on committee files, but subsequently learned it was inaccurate.

Velde said he had taken Mrs. Meyer's letter and had taken appropriate disciplinary action against the employes who gave him the wrong information.

The Post said Velde refused to withdraw his accusation "unless Mrs. Meyer withdrew what she said about him and about Sen. McCarthy."

Mrs. Meyer called Velde's statement an "outrageous falsehood" and alleged the Atlantic city conference was "the sort of reckless irresponsible and false utterance that is going to be heard in many of the teaching profession."

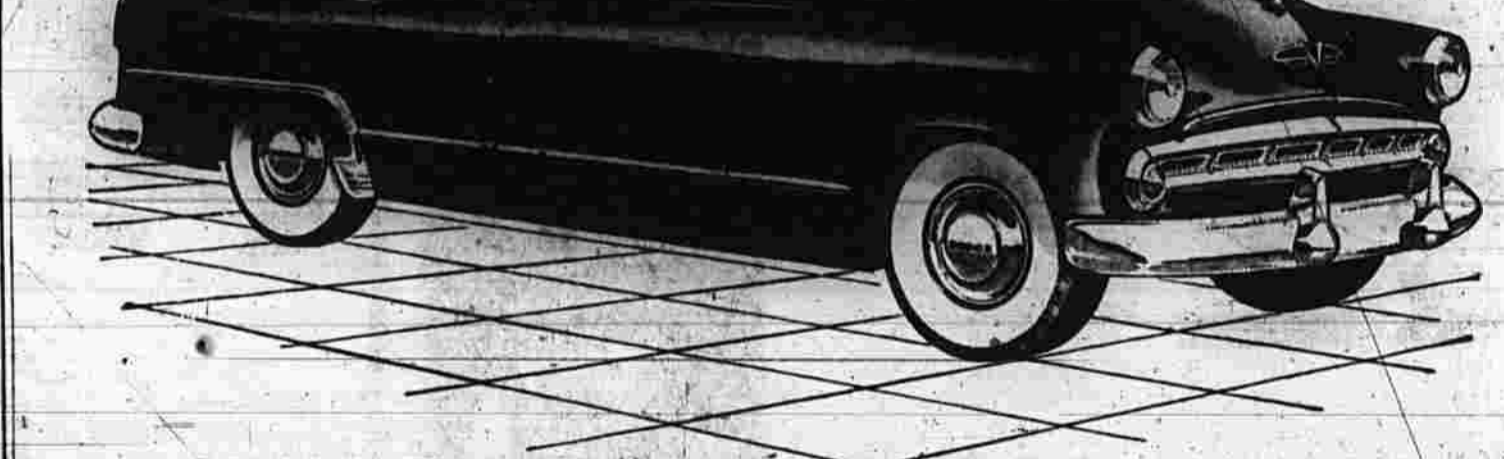

(Continued From Page One) The Boston newspapers "He did not elaborate. Father Feeney's stand on salvation previously had resulted in the loss of his priestly functions. That occurred in April, 1949, through an order by Archbishop Richard J. Cushing which also barred Catholicism from frequenting St. Benedict's center, Cambridge, where Father Feeney's followers attend classes run by the rebellion priest. He was also dismissed from the Jesuit Order for his refusal to give up his opposition to the church's interpretation.

Church sources pointed out that excommunication, while depriving Father Feeney of the right to administer and receive sacraments in the church, does not mean he is unfraternal. That solemn rite is unlikely to be carried out since it requires the presence of the priest before a group of church leaders, the sources said. At such a ceremony, they said, the priest's vestments are removed and he is publicly "excommunicated."

The Vatican decree climaxed a four-year-old controversy which became public with the dismissal of four instructors from Boston College, a school conducted by the Jesuit Order. They were charged with teaching the Feeney doctrine that salvation is impossible outside the Catholic church.
