

Young Fanatics Rule Top Red German Bosses

 Berlin—(INA)—The President, Premier and Deputy Premier of Communist Germany are today, for all practical purposes, prisoners of their young, fanatical bodyguards.

Since the great new purge began in Eastern Europe, thousands have died in the West, including high government officials. With Germany and her military know-how this continent's fittest youth, Moscow fears the loss of top dog Hetch leaders, whose departure would be a shocking propaganda setback.

I have learned that 75 "Special Security Agents" have orders to "fire without hesitation" at any slight attempt by President Wilhelm Pieck, Premier Otto Grotewohl, or Deputy Premier Walter Ulbricht.

In a land of double crosses and triple spy it is possible, during the current blood bath, that these three long-time Kremlin pets might slip from favor—into the hangman's noose.

The bodyguards, 17 to 24, were selected from the 80,000 "elite activists" of the Free German Youth (FDJ) movement, regarded by Comrade Stalin as his most dependable organization in East Germany.

Recently the U. S. High Commissioner's office stated: "The security of the Soviet Zone is fast passing into the hands of youths trained by the FDJ."

Your bodyguard, in a world of brutal politics, often becomes your warder. This was the case during the last days of Adolf Hitler, when Gestapo Chief Heinrich Himmler turned his right to "protect" Nazi leaders into the power to dominate them.

Remember: The Government of Red Germany sits in East Berlin but a few minutes from the American, French and British sectors.

Concerned about world publicity at this time, when they're trying to scare West Germany out of joining the European Army, the Communists are striving to screen off these last holes in the curtain.

Before Pieck, Grotewohl or Ulbricht—the terrible triplets of Teutonic communism—can leave their homes, even to air a dachshund, they must check the broad shoulders of Special Security Agents who clear it with the Staats Sicherheits Dienst (State Security Service).

The guards' back pistols and

Russian burp guns, with round cartridge belts like motion picture reels. They form their own unit inside the SS, the new secret police which carbon copies the Gestapo to the last rubber hose.

Their Mr. Big is FDJ Chief Erich Honecker, 40-year-old Communist who somehow survived a tortured trip through six Nazi concentration camps.

An old hand at in-fighting with knee or broken bottle, Honecker is the Communist youth group "Spartakus" in street brawls with Hitler Jugend until old Von Hindenburg gave Adolf his baton of power.

He shuttles between Berlin and Moscow for the Kremlin's blessing and a peep at the latest black list.

The Special Security Agents were picked for blind belief, ability to think fast as an International Business Machine, and the physique of halfbacks.

They come from urban laboring families. Farmers who love their soil and are fighting collectivization, are "untrustworthy" and intellectuals with an idea of their own are thumbed down by calculating commissars.

Since the rugged '70 entered

their barracks in the Aldershof section of East Berlin they have been as isolated, as monks and encouraged to think themselves "Supermen."

They're forbidden friendly chats or even jiggers of schnapps with the men they guard. A "political collaboration" is a capital offense.

Instructors tested them in knife fights and with strangle holds, searching for a flicker of fear. In the Secret Service GHQ in Lichtenberg they watched backsliders questioned, with blackjack and boot, and learned still finer methods of booming tongues.

As I watched the six-foot "Supermen" tower over their charges at public events in East Berlin, their blonde hair worn heavy, long and oiled, I was reminded of yesterday's young SS "elite" troopers.

With terrible efficiency the SS ushered Nazi victims into the gas chambers—and when their world collapsed—fought with animal courage trying to deny Russian tanks the approach to Hitler's Berlin bunker.

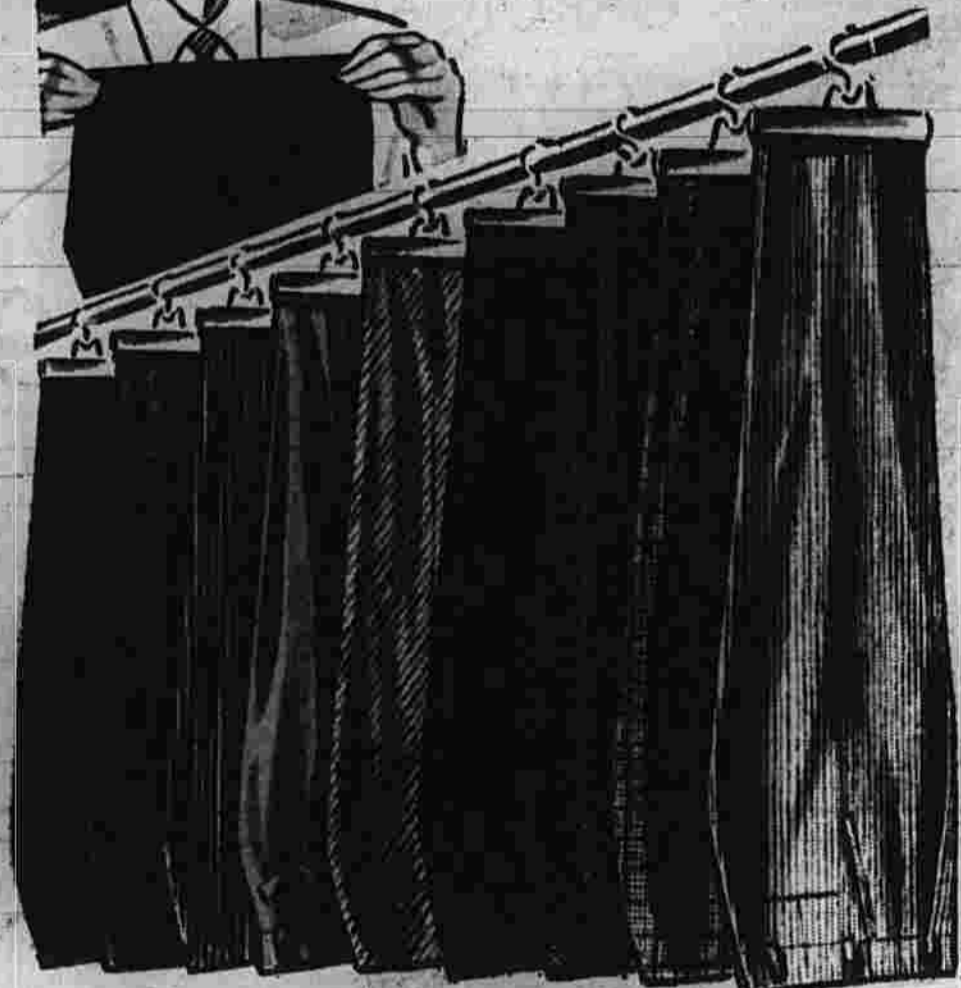

Throughway Foes Ask For Turnpike Authority

Hartford, Feb. 25.—Scores of opponents of the Fairfield County throughway urged at a lengthy Connecticut legislative hearing yesterday that the \$135,000,000 project be approved from the State Highway department.

They would establish a turnpike authority, instead, which would have complete control of choosing a route for the highway and be responsible for its financing, building and maintenance.

Amid bitter recriminations, they expressed themselves strongly against the building of the throughway along the route chosen by Highway Commissioner G. Albert Hill.

Under the commissioner's plan, the highway would be built adjacent to the Long Island road, a stretch of about 45 miles. The commissioner's route was criticized by the crowd, which packed the big hall of the House in the State Capitol.
