Formerly Had Wealth

In former years the church was considered quite wealthy but during the depression years failure of the Hartford City Bank and Trust Company occasioned a big loss.

At last meetings today and tomorrow, probably with Italian Premier Alcide de Gasperi in attendance in a peace-making role, Adenauer and Bidault were slated to take up the other major point still at issue between them—France's desire for special concessions in the European army.

Though these were deferred until after running head-on into the combined opposition of the five major powers, the meeting of U. S. President Eisenhower's administration for speedy formation of the international force.

Tip to Parliament

It remained to be seen whether the French parliament would back the EDC treaty. Although the treaty was signed last May, none of the six nations have yet ratified it.

The big concrete achievement of the ministers' conference was a unanimous decision that someday Europe must be one great common market. How to gradually reduce tariffs and other barriers to achieve this goal was referred to economic experts of the six nations.

The most optimistic of the ministers after their meeting was De Gasperi who said, "If all continues to go well" the EDC treaty may be ratified by all six nations this spring. He predicted Italian ratification would take place by June.

Some signals in Paris

In a news conference, Gen. Charles de Gaulle, leader of the powerful French People's Rally party (RPF), savagely attacked the European army plan as an American scheme to use European soldiers and achieve American military domination of continental affairs.

A few hours later, French Defense Minister Rene Pleven pleaded for quick ratification of the RPF treaty at a closed session of the National Assembly's defense committee.

Many French political figures, in addition to Gaullist leaders, have major doubts and reservations about the treaty to arm 500,000 troops from Germany—France's traditional enemy—even in an international army.

Some sources here considered that Bidault's partial back-track from France's previous insistence on concessions probably would arouse the very factions in the assembly that the treaty protocols originally were drafted to placate.

The other nations at the conference were unanimously opposed to the French change. Germany was particularly bitter. All agreed that if the protocols went through, France theoretically could pull all her troops out of the European army and still retain her status within the defense community organization.
