U. S. Refused Scovill Shells During Strike

Waterbury, March 26.—(AP)—A manufacturer said today that the government refused to accept munitions "badly needed for Korea" from his company while it was involved in a 19 week strike last year.

The strike during which Scovill refused to allow its ship munitions which had been inspected and packed, or to inspect munitions that were being sold were badly needed for Korea.

"We suggested that we ship them to some arsenal for inspection. As long as the strike lasted we were not allowed to ship to the government."

The strike did not close the plant, about 1,300 non-strikers working there.

During shortage in New York, Leslie Gould, financial editor of the New York Journal American, wrote today in Scovill's report that the strike occurred "at the time when munitions were critically short in Korea."

Gould wrote that it was Army Ordnance that refused to accept munitions from union struck plants.



Pay Hike Pushed By State Workers Hartford, March 26 (AP)—State employees, pressing their fight for a pay increase before a General Assembly committee, claim it is only fair the state should grant a pay boost, but agreed they had not the slightest idea where the state would get the \$10,000,000 to do so.


