## Justice Clark Linked To Mail Fraud Case

### Probe Set To Reveal New Angle

Washington, April 22—(AP)—House investigators started a public inquiry today to learn whether the Justice Department under former Atty. Gen. Tom Clark "was improperly induced" to drop a big mail fraud case. Clark is now a Supreme Court Justice.

Case Dismissed  
Rep. Keating (R-N.Y.), chairman of a House Judiciary subcommittee investigating the Justice Department, said Clark approved "abrupt dismissal" of the case in June 1944.

Former Atty.-Gen. James P. McGranery, who stepped out with the Truman administration last January, turned the case over to the subcommittee last year and called it "one of the biggest mail fraud cases" in history.
