(Continued From Page One) A report on the whole story "right now," he added: "But I can't go into it entirely and I don't understand all myself just yet."

He said the big question that needs a great amount of elucidation, the situation is very complicated. It's not a simple matter of a bomb unless it's put at considerable length. I couldn't go into it on an occasion like this for one thing it isn't organized in my own mind.

There were no military maneuvers following the blast. The detonation first put off for several days. They look at things differently. "I'll put it this way—in our country, practicing journalism as we know it, it could come under suspicion of espionage under their laws."

Several newsmen asked if Oatis was holding back answers with the idea of giving data to the government or exclusively to the Associated Press. Oatis said no, and Starzel told the newsmen that he had no such intention.
