## Minister Tells Kiwanians Words Worth Remembering

Rev. Lloyd F. Worley, Principal Speaker at Memorial Program

Rev. Lloyd F. Worley, of the First Methodist Church of Hartford, spoke to the Manchester Kiwanians yesterday noon on "Words Worth Remembering." A Memorial Day program, began by contrasting the well remembered words spoken by Abraham Lincoln in his Gettysburg Address. The world will little note, nor long remember what we say here, but it can never forget what we did here.

Lincoln was wrong, said Rev. Worley. The world has virtually forgotten the deeds which the speech commemorated. Ever since he uttered the phrase "government of the people, by the people, for the people," has been on the lips of the people of the world seeking their way.

Worth Remembering

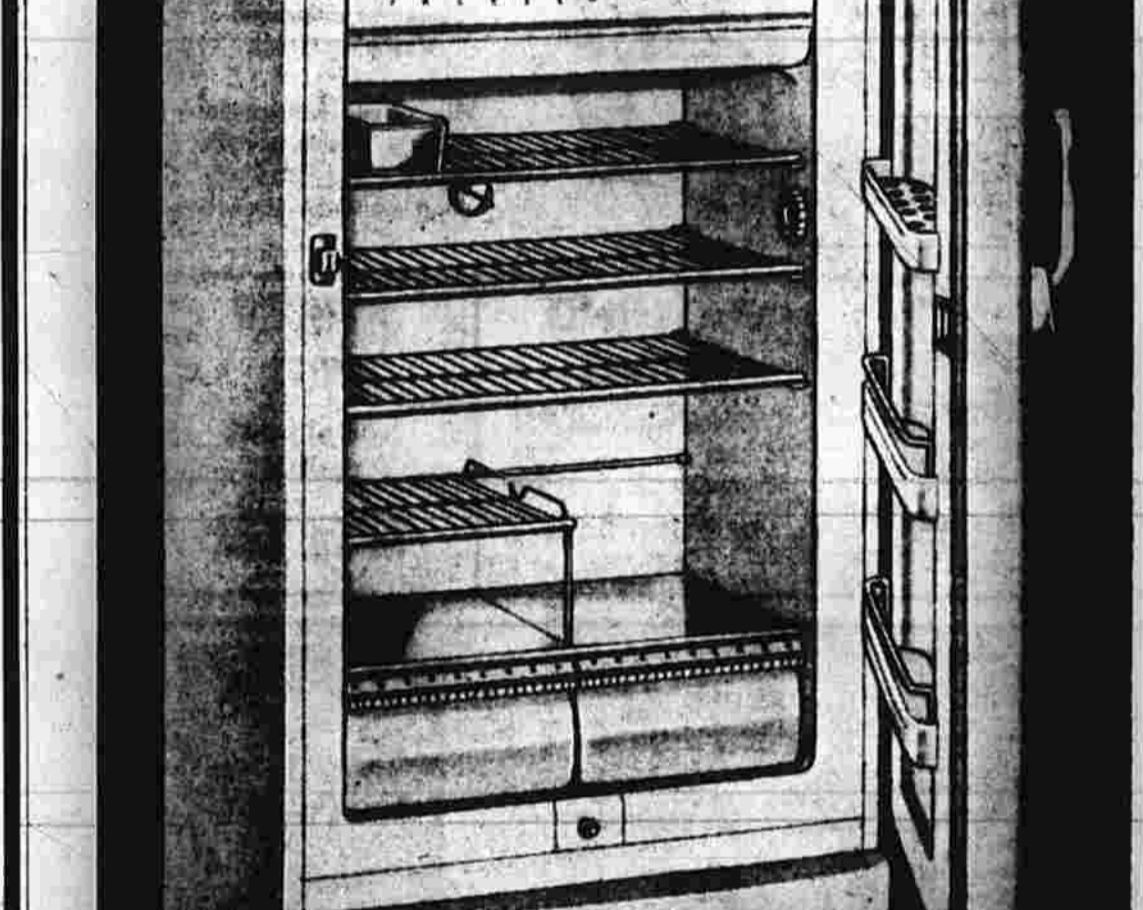
