Coroner Says Schwarm Caused Highway Death

Ackerman Reports on Finding in Car Crash That Killed Local Girl

The death of Susan C. Johnson, 16-year-old Manchester, 11½ H school junior, in the three-car crash on Twin Hills in Coventry June 2 was "caused by the criminal act, omission or carelessness of Robert Henry Schwarm, Jr.," Coroner Bernard J. Ackerman for "United County" has found following his inquest. The "dying" was "killed" by Schwarm's car "driving north, over the highway into the path of Car 2 (the car containing the four youths and the one in which the Johnson girl was killed), head on," the coroner reported.

Death was caused by a fractured skull and laceration of the brain, the report indicates.

Schwarm is the only victim of the accident who is still hospitalized. He was in Hartford Hospital for about 15 days before being transferred to the Windham Private Hospital where he is still recovering from his injuries.

Schwarm, 40, lives at Brewster St., North Coventry. The coroner referred to the case by number: Schwarm was operating Car 1 in an easterly direction on route 11 in Coventry, about eight-tenths of a mile east of the Bolton town line and only a short distance from the road where he would have turned off to reach his home.

Car 2 was operated by Angelo Tamborini, 18, of 419 Valley St., Willimantic, and, according to the coroner's report, was driving on 247 Jackson St. and the Johnson girl, Albert J. Todd, 26, of 379 Porter St., was driving the third car. The latter vehicles were both traveling in the same direction as the youth.

The operator of Car 1, who apparently was driving closely behind Car 2, had no opportunity to apply the brakes when Car 2 struck Car 1 from the rear immediately after it had been struck by Car 3, the coroner's report continues.

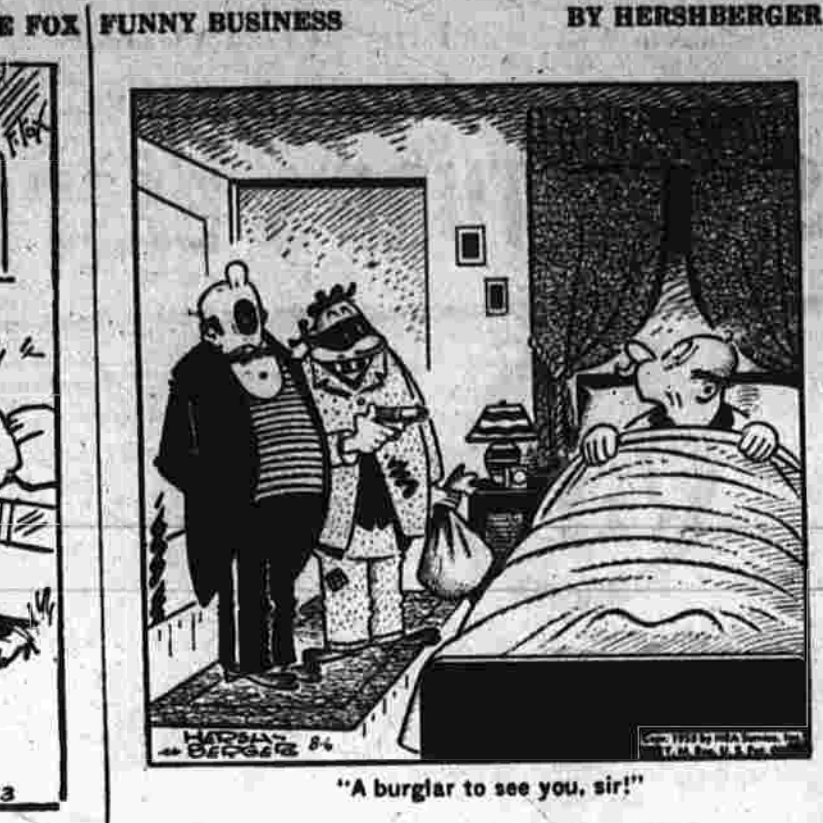

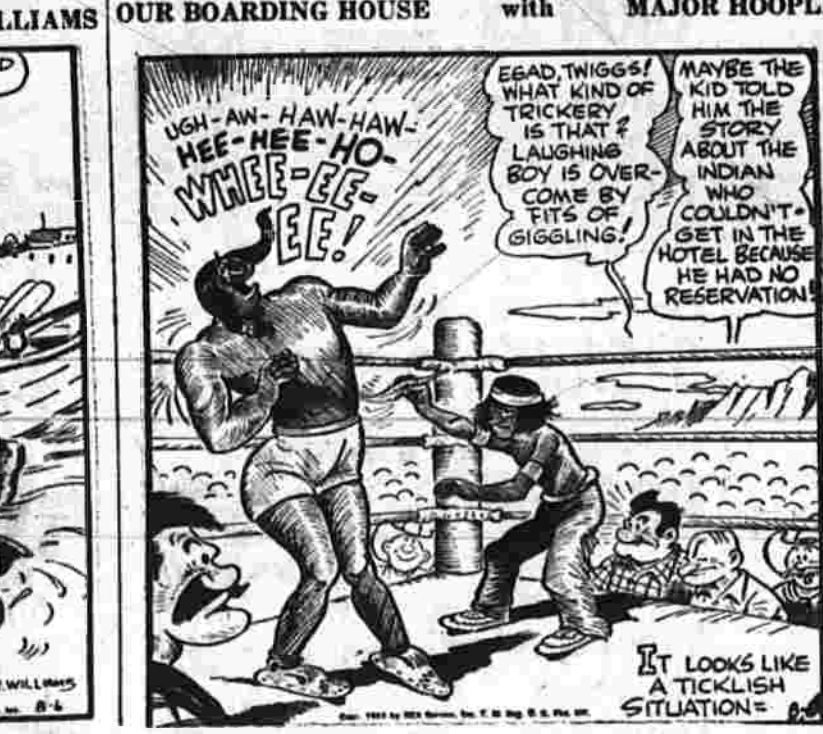
