The Chinese Communists and the North Koreans.

Dulles said that the relations between the two sides are "very much on our minds" and that he has been in charge of administering the armistice, including the 48th Army in Korea, going to the front to see the situation and to see what is possible to get back to American boys.

A bit later in the new conference, Dulles was asked to elaborate on what he had said in his previous press conference. He said that he had been checking to find out if they can furnish the names of any prisoners who may be returned.

Then Dulles said that "it is the primary duty of the government to return to their homes as many as possible."

Asked whether that meant that this country in turn would hold some Communist prisoners, the secretary said that would be a normal procedure.

In reply to another question, Dulles said that the government is refusing no official word that any American prisoners of war are being returned.

He noted that there have been reports that a few prisoners have been turned down a chance for release.

Dulles was asked whether he held some Communist prisoners, and he said that he had a number of prisoners who had been captured in Korea and North Korea and prisoners who have been convicted of crimes since they were captured.

He added that they would not be returned until they had been convicted of a crime and that the United Nations prisoners who have been convicted of a crime are being returned to their homes.

Dulles was asked whether it could be assumed that Eisenhower's policy is that the relations between the two sides would have to be taken in the Communist way. The secretary replied that he was not going to say anything for the president.

Dulles was asked whether he had been told that the president had been turned down a chance for release.

The secretary told newsmen that Dulles "is not doing as his contribution to the peace effort is concerned."

Dulles said that he had emphasized the fact that the Japanese government is assuming a larger responsibility for security of the area, and that the United States is assuming a "great deal" in Korea and that it represented a big step toward lasting peace.

Like Dulles, Dulles said he was much impressed by the organization for the exchange of prisoners. The ambassador also said that he had found the United Nations forces in Korea more impressive.

Eisenhower's conference with Dulles, Lodge and Robertson took place in the President's small study in the White House administration building.

After the conference, Dulles negotiated with a U. S. South Korean mutual security pact.

Dulles was asked whether he had most complete and that they had "ended on a note of cordiality."

Referring to the communique made public in Korea, Dulles said he wanted to stress that no agreements were made at the conference.

He repeated that he had received from the Soviet side "categorical assurance" that the Korean army will be withdrawn to the United Nations Command and observe armistice provisions until the mutual agreement between the United States and South Korea "can be expected to go into effect."

It is only to a question, the secretary said he looks for the treaty to be ratified by the Senate by next February.

Dulles was asked whether he had any information on how many Communist prisoners of war the Communists might be withholding. He replied that he did not.

The number is purely speculative, he said in connection with his talks in Japan. Dulles said his announcement in connection with the United States wants to return the Amami-Oshima Islands to Japan.

After the conference, Dulles returned to his office in the State Department.

"So far," Rhee said, "our army has made great progress with the understanding and sympathetic assistance given by the United States. However, the navy and air force have been comparatively less developed. Henceforth, henceforth our armed forces will be considerably strengthened with positive assistance from the United States."

Much of Rhee's two page statement was devoted to explaining to his people the policy that he had adopted last week during the visit here of Secretary of State Dulles and the multi-million dollar economic aid program.

Rhee told his people that pending solution of our problems, there were many things to be done and that "that of all we are required to concentrate our power in rehabilitating the nation's economy."

Then Rhee went on to say that it had been agreed that the 16 United Nations with troops in Korea should be held in readiness to "achieve unification of our peninsula" if the political conditions should be such that it would be in the interest of the peninsula.

"In consideration of these circumstances," Rhee said, "I do not regret the armistice agreement, although we agreed not to obstruct the truce. If we succeeded in the political conference it would be a really fortunate event and it is not, we will have suffered no great damage. Our object is to achieve unification of our peninsula."
