(Continued From Page One) commands in historic disagreement over policy two years ago. The Air Force has been openly unhappy over the trend which seems to be taking form in the defense situation.

The Air Force fought for the 142-wing goal set by the old JCS but the Air Force at 129 wings pending the new JCS study to determine how many wings this nation should have for a balanced force and defense. A wing has 30 to 75 planes, depending on the combat mission.

Firefighters tried desperately, but in vain, to save the boy's lives by artificial respiration and the McGuire Veterans Administration Hospital.

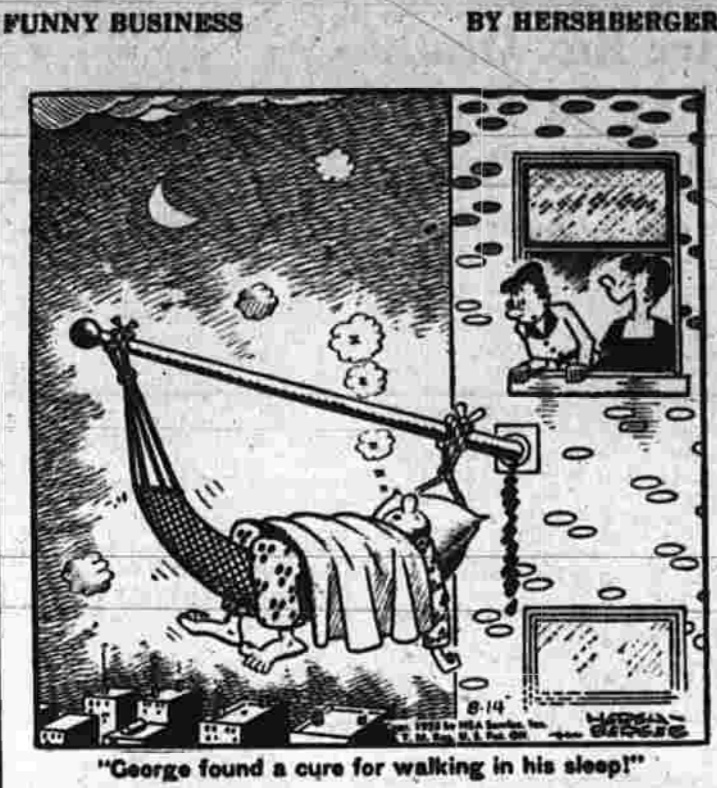

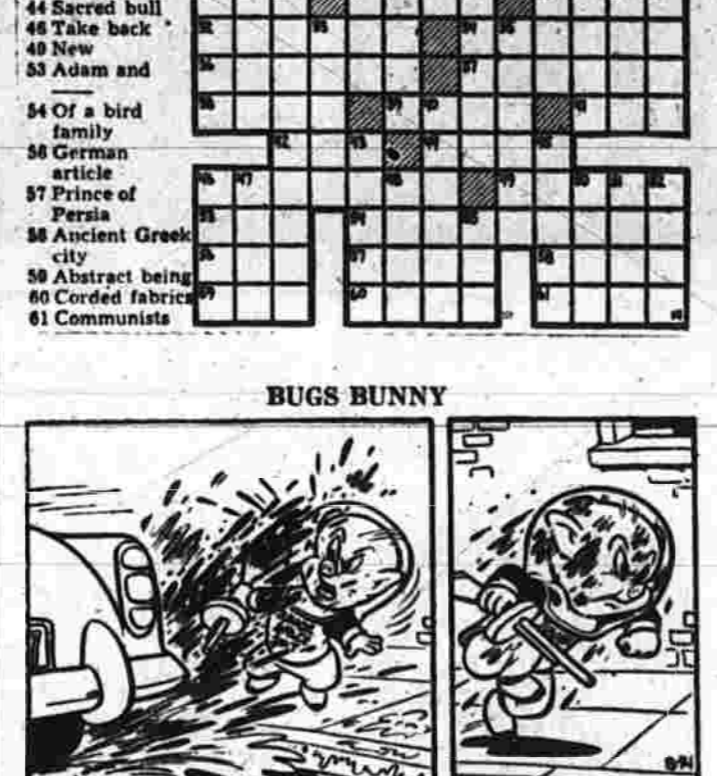
