### Photographers Tick Like Human Beings

 (For Hal Boyle) asked if he didn't want to come out of the snow and mountains for New York City—reading one of Frank Ross' stories of life in a Chinese prison camp. He had written it down to bring to a party, but he was in a hurry to get back to the front because the best pictures were there.

Frank or "Pappy" as we called him, is a news photographer. The Chinese grabbed him in that bleak and anxious winter of 1950 when the dam went bust in Korea. Now, 22 months and several lifetimes later, he has been sprung. His memoirs make fascinating reading.

As you may know, there is an eternal debate in the in-stated trade of ours over the question: Are photographers people? Personally, I think they are, although there are many points that are conceded to the opposite side of the argument. The important fact is, I suppose, that news photographers see the world exclusively through that square window under his camera.

And this, for him, is the "only true and valid world." There, there, few things that happen outside are likely to be seen.

For a long moment, nobody spoke.

Moreover, he is a harassed man. A reporter can come along, and pick up the details from someone else who saw it. But a photographer has to be there when the trigger at the precise split second—or else.

When you can understand in a hurry to get back to work, the pictures were.

### 'Five-Too-Many' Marks Protest Of Red Tactics

Hong Kong, Aug. 20 (AP)—The language of Communism, where a stray becomes a deviant and a 5-syllable word can be found in getting some new words from the Chinese.

Already there has been added the five-anti, or the Wu-Fan. It means the effort to stop bribery, lawlessness, cheating the state, stealing state property and stealing state economic intelligence.

Now comes the "five-too-many." The five-too-many has come to mean a national rural protest by farmers and Communist rural workers against 100 many things, 200 many meetings, 300 many documents and forms, 400 many organizations and 500 many concurrent posts for cadres.

This latest "five" springs from the Reds' hurry-up efforts to create the farm system of China, to change taxes, to kill landlords, to form cooperatives, to force donations and to increase production.

The Reds ignored the usual unit of Communism's typical attitude of "let it all in a minute, starting a movement which was an abortive, accompanying it with a lot of noise and a lot of self-criticism (a sort of national confession).

It has come to mean the five-too-many.

Out of the five-too-many has come a few facts from the vast world of the Reds. It is a new proof that the Reds, working their will in prison camps in the other war, a third narrowly missed it, had been set down over the ocean.

 "We also," Howard H. Bell of the Library said today, "are interested in the extremely popular." "He wrote them in a gallop. Before his death in 1939 he had proved that few authors could write faster, turn out a greater number of books or get themselves more widely read."

He crunched away at the rate of 100,000 words a month, enough to fill an average size foot. During the first 30 years of his career, 25 of his novels sold 17 million copies. Someone has figured that 58 million people have read one or more of his 50 books.

Not only do passengers on today's luxury liners have leisure for epicurean adventures, but their cost is absorbed completely in first-class passage fares.

"Today, when the only competition between passenger ships is based on service and food," says Arch Mundy, "modern ships are all pretty luxurious and they take about the same length of time to cross."

All of which has turned first-class ship travel into an eating parade. Mundy, a highly prejudiced seaman, believes his ship, the United States, is a cuisine second to none in the world, floating or stationary. He is in charge of the liner's first-class dining room and sees to it that the practically nothing that is in season his pampered passengers can't order, from a tiny, tiny Russian caviar, through the gummy family grouse, partridge and pheasant to the last course, a rich and succulent duck with a sauce and garnish with material.

A long-time student of in-transit eating habits, Mundy notes a great difference between the food yearning of outboard passengers and those coming aboard. Crews go for a European vacation, they go for rich, fancy dishes and a little bit of a lavish hand. On the trip home, most passengers are simple chaps and chaps, who curl their tired lips at sauces and garnish with material.

"I've seen many a passenger sail through a meal starting with caviar and ending with a clear turtle soup, sole venique, breast of guinea hen, avocado salad and wind up with crepe maitre. Any place else, such a meal would cost a fortune."

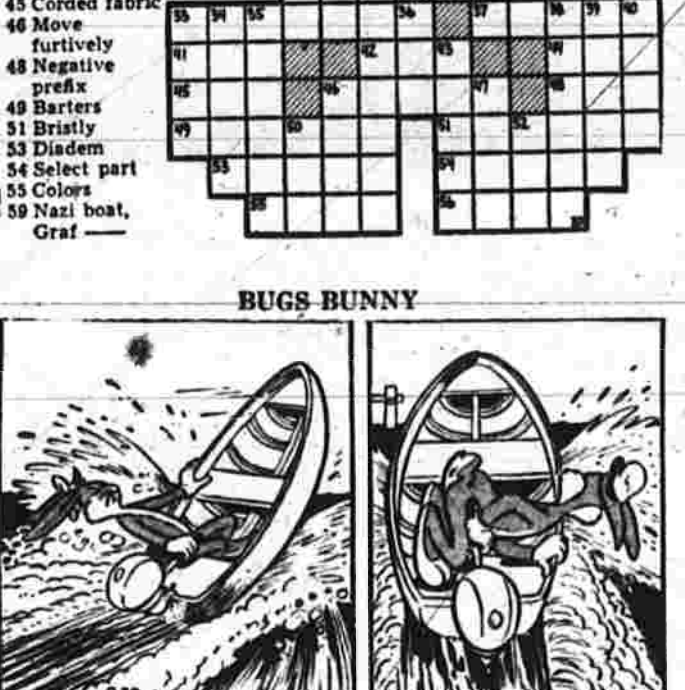

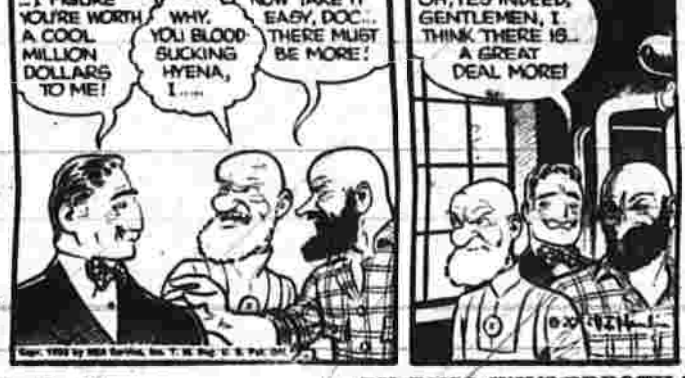
