Marines Not Pleased With Korea Armistice

New York (AP) — Capt. Ben Price, of the U. S. Marines, walked into the office the other day, fresh from Korea.

Naturally, I asked, "What do you guys think of the armistice?" "Not much," said Ben. "They're not satisfied to have it end this way."

He went on to say that the war could have been carried to a complete military decision—in our favor.

Coming from a Marine, of course, any other report would have been a surprise. But there it was, the opinion of a Marine, in two totally different roles.

On his first hitch in Korea, he was a combat Marine. He came over early in the summer of 1950, and he was in the front line when the Chinese first landed on the peninsula.

After the North Koreans collapsed, and the war disintegrated into a pursuit and mop-up, Ben came home.

He had been in the Marines in the second World War, however. So, a year or so ago, Uncle Sam called him and presently he was on his way back out to the old stamping ground, this time, in uniform.

In short, he has seen things that most of us never could.

"What we should have done," he went on, "is smash up the army and then the Chinese would have been in a state of confusion."

The Chinese have been at their death-defiance, presumably a system of bunkers, trenches and emplacements going back four or five miles, solidly.

"We didn't think much of the depth of the defenses," he said. "Every time we punched through the outer crust, they would retreat quickly and pretty well. But it didn't look to us as though they had the material and morale to hold out for more than a few days."

This attitude pretty well with the opinion of Gen. James A. Van Fleet. When he came back, some months ago, he told this story.

"The Chinese are nothing once you get 'em moving backward," he said. "I don't know," he said. "Nobody could make sense out of it. We would take one of their positions, and then pull back—on order."

He said the Marine officers reasoned that they were losing more men in the stationary war than would have been lost in an all-out push.

"Which officers," I asked. "The big brass," he said.

All of them," he said. "Any second lieutenant would tell you that we should have been pushing instead of sitting there."

So if you drive up to the Yalk River again, then what? It would still be necessary to keep the whole Army more or less intact, guarding the long border, even though the fighting had stopped.

Ben conceded that. But he added, "You're going to have to keep most of them."

France Awaits Assembly Vote On Constitution

In the first place, the problem of the Communists, the constitutional revisions now awaiting ratification by the French Parliament are also designed to relieve one of that nation's problems which is most often criticized in the United States—government instability.

The steps are tentative, and some of them more psychological than material. In this field the measures which are largely procedural, designed to improve the functions of Parliament and thereby reduce the friction between the legislative body and the cabinet which have been falling so frequently.

When the present constitution was adopted after the war, Charles DeGaulle had a big organization demanding that, to meet the crisis of the times, the executive branch be given a great many more centralized powers than the numerous other parties were willing to see.

In one respect, however, considerable progress was made to ward eliminating situations such as that developed last spring, when one cabinet fell right in the midst of serious negotiations in both the domestic and international fields.

Invested in any one man or one regime. The resulting document was therefore overworked with checks and not so many balances. There was a long battle between those who wished to make a wholly new start and those who wanted to return to the forms of the Third Republic. The Republicans got the edge, but only in a compromise which left many loopholes which, it was recognized even then, would have to be filled in as weaknesses were revealed in practice.

Beyond the procedural revisions mentioned above, there isn't much in the new draft designed to keep a cabinet in office for a while once it has been established. This is a greatly complicated by the necessity, ever since the war, of coalition government. Observers are not very optimistic that even the present national fiscal crisis will present sufficiently clear issues to promote the party men, which would give the nation fewer and stronger parties, able to be re-elected.

The time list No. 888 is published on Aug. 21, but a few of the 14,277 American killed, wounded or missing in Korea will be identified by name and category of casualty.

Some held back from publication a handful of casualty notifications because their best efforts to date have failed to locate the next of kin which each serviceman registers when he puts on his uniform.
