Modes Denies Union Claims

Hahn Disputes Charge Britain-Hall Layoffs Purposeful Discharge

A spokesman for the management of two locally controlled garment unions, said today that an advertisement in the New Britain Herald yesterday, stating that 40 employees were being replaced, was untrue.

"No one has been replaced," Hahn said, adding "The suit business is in a slump. We are working as much as any suit factory in the area. The only layoffs in the union and the union knows it. In the year, and the union doesn't know when there will be an improvement in the picture."

He said the workers have been laid off on the basis of seniority and only because there isn't enough production to keep them.

The approximately 400 Manchester Modes employees have not been affected by any similar layoffs.

"The union has claimed that we laid off on a temporary basis but have now been discharged in an attempt to force workers into the union," Hahn said. "I am urging these workers to vote now and I have sent a telegram to Governor Lodge protesting 'company tactics' in asking for an interview to petition the state."

Hahn said the election—the second one being held to decide whether the workers at the two plants want to be represented by the National Labor Relations Board, "is going to go against the NLRB."

Concerning the workers' right to vote, Hahn said, "That is a right to be decided by the NLRB. We want the election to reflect the wishes of all employees."

Some 700 workers at Britain-Hall and Manchester Modes, which are controlled by Sidney Edlis, of Manchester, rejected the union's bid to be represented by the NLRB at an election March 25.

That vote was thrown out, however, after the NLRB, acting on an appeal, found that the company had committed 23 violations of the Taft-Hartley labor law.
