Do you suppose Manchester is in a hurry to get a new project that would help the world's needy children? The list started by church groups in 1951, in that spirit of children's collecting week for themselves, they would collect pennies, nickels or dimes for UNICEF, which would be spent for milk, medicines and clothing for the less fortunate children of other countries.

This venture proved so popular that in 1952 more than 500 communities in 41 states tried it. Over \$2,000,000 was collected. Indications are that even more will try it in 1953.

Spain Ready on Pact To Allow U. S. Bases

Agreement Prepared At Madrid

Washington, Sept. 26 (AP)—The United States and Spain today signed a 20-year defense agreement giving the country the right to develop and use naval and air bases on Spanish soil and assuring Spain of military equipment from the United States.



By JOHN N. HIGHTOWER Washington, Sept. 26 (AP)—Franco's Spain, long shunned by the victors of World War II, becomes this weekend a partner of the United States in the West's defense against the danger of Soviet attack.

A set of agreements, prepared for immediate signature and by the U. S. and Spanish governments, would give America the right to use about a half dozen air and naval bases in Spanish territory.

U. S. Aid Assured Spain, for its part, would get assistance of U. S. military and economic assistance, as well as the prospect of heavy American spending to outfit the bases.

Three agreements covering use of the bases, military aid and economic help, have been worked out during 17 months of long and sometimes difficult negotiations. They climax a sweeping but incomplete reversion in American-Spanish relations.

Officials who said the agreement's details would not be disclosed until later in the week, earlier speculation had dwelt upon the use of U. S. bases at Cadix, Cartagena and Ferrol and bases in the vicinity of Madrid, Barcelona and Seville.

All present facilities are described as inadequate and in need of considerable expansion.
