The Cycles Are Swift

The thing which is hardest to realize, as another anniversary of Pearl Harbor comes around, is that the event itself was 12 long years ago.

The war which followed lasted four years. The tortured lack of peace which ensued has lasted eight. It does not seem that it could be this long; it seems that Pearl Harbor must have been nearer yesterday.

Yet it must have been at least that long. It usually takes at least a decade for the memories of one war to begin considering themselves fit allies for the next war. It usually takes at least a decade for a "day of infamy" to recede far enough to begin to receive classification as somebody's mistake. It usually takes the world at least a decade to begin to begin to develop the attitude for new war.

If the war began for us 42 years ago and we are about on schedule, after all, in about eight more years, unless we turn the schedule by cutting out the usual non-sensical period of slim disarmament, it will be normal time for new war.

This is writing in a vein of sarcasm, we confess. Yet it is a sarcasm which is heavy with a sense of sorrow and tragedy, rather than with any sense of smart-aleck ill will.

For as we run up this period in our living, in world history, it seems to us that there is precious little that is new in it that is in the good, and not merely because it seems to us that, except for one or two things, this cycle of history is like any other, and, therefore, the expectation of human conduct and history which will follow it the same as in the past, also. And it seems to us that the one or two things which do offer some difference are not noted and emphasized enough by all of us, not given that devoted attention once passionately and realistically, which might improve the chance that they could change the course of human behavior and of history.

The only things we have that are different are the United Nations, already somewhat stronger than any previous world organization has been allowed to be, and the chance that it can be made still stronger, until it is the representative of world law against war, with power to enforce the law it makes. This organization, and the chance for it, alone distinguish the world today from the world of 1918, which was eight years after the end of another war. It alone offers the possibility that, this time, mankind may break the cycle.

Dishonest If He Loses

Last Friday, as the nation was confronted with Senator McCarthy's appeal for a wire-tapping to the President campaign, the Toledo Blade, as eminently conservative newspaper, had an idea which probably occurred to many Americans: Why should those Americans who happened to support the President not be heard from, even if McCarthy had asked only those who supported him to send messages? So the Toledo Blade offered to forward Washington a communication supporting the President and to place on it the names of all who called upon requesting it. The tide of telephone calls began immediately after the appearance of the Blade's offer. The Blade went off to press that same midnight, thus giving against any concerted pressure group operation in the matter.

When it stopped taking calls, some were being favoring the President and 24 favoring McCarthy.

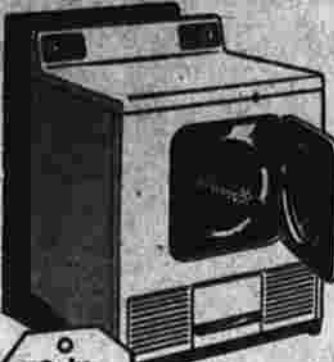

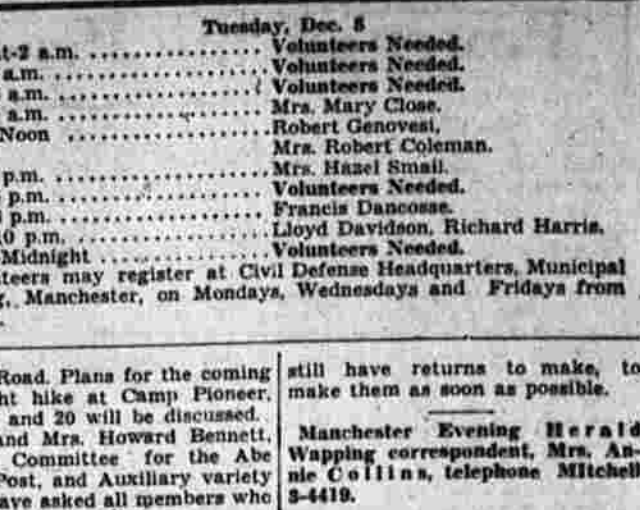
