Milk Price Increase Seen In Union, Companies Pact

Hartford, Dec. 11.—Creation of a Health, Welfare, Pensions and Pension Fund for approximately 400 union employees and a greater Hartford-New Britain milk companies was announced today in a joint statement by dairy and labor representatives.
The agreement, retroactive to Dec. 1, was being by Henry G. Daughina, secretary-treasurer and business manager of Local 520, International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen and Helpers of America, A.F.L., to "one us in the union here would be a real step forward."

Superhighway Plans Transport Revolution Grips Usually Staid New England

(Continued from Page One)

England states for superhighway completed, planned or contemplated:

Connecticut — Best known are the 38-mile Wilbur Cross Parkway and its continuation, the Merritt Parkway, leading into New York.

The Merritt was completed in 1940 at a cost of 21 million dollars and the Cross still under construction for \$17,000,000.

Known as "The Gateway to New England" the two roads were long the envy of other New England states for permitting motorists fast travel through billboards, scenic country.

Overshadowing these two tollways is a programmed 150-mile expressway from Greenwich to Killingly on the Rhode Island border to be completed in 1957 or 1958 at an estimated cost of 2-3 million dollars.

This expressway ultimately would become part of a proposed tri-state highway running more than 200 miles from New Haven through Rhode Island to the tip of Cape Cod in Massachusetts.

The project, recommended by state highway officials and endorsed by the three governors, would cost 74 million, of which 17 million would be Connecticut's share.

The tri-state highway requires legislative authorization by the three states and officials hope it may be completed sometime between 1960 and 1965.

Maine—Maine's famed Maine Turnpike, a 45-mile limited-access superhighway with a speed limit of 60 miles an hour from Kittery to Portland, will be extended an additional 85 miles to Augusta.

This second section is expected to be completed in 1955.

The Kittery-Portland part was opened in late 1947 and cost \$20,000,000, about \$450,000 a mile. The extension cost will run about \$33,000 a mile.

Financed Privately

The turnpike is financed by private capital and operated by the Maine Turnpike Authority, a quasi-public agency chartered by the state.

Officials estimate the saving in time for motorists on the Kittery

cost of 8 million dollars to end the most of eight main traffic arteries converging on U. S. Route 6 in Olney Square in Providence.

The second is a three million dollar elevated highway as the Manhattan interchange in Cranston on State Route 9 to New York.

Vermont—Vermont at present has no superhighway program.

However, Vermont's U. S. Senator, George D. Aiken recently suggested that a superhighway be built from Boston to Montreal and that officials of Massachusetts and the Green Mountain State get together to work out plans.

Aiken said he hopes one of Vermont's legislators will put forward such a proposal at the state's next legislative session.

Alkan said such a highway would be immeasurable benefit to the state's recreational business, that it would draw new residents and help the area attract industry.

Huge Italian Strike Hits Vital Services

higher pay and are protesting against Civil Service reforms they fear will curtail their right to strike. Industrial workers want wage boosts and other benefits.

The disorder was reported during the first hours of the strike.

Italy's National Railway System ground to a virtual halt at midnight, the hour set for the start of the walkout. It was scheduled to end the following midnight.

During the morning, a few major passenger trains rolled out of Rome and Milan manned by army crews but they carried only a small fraction of the day's ordinary number of travelers. There was no assurance the trains would reach their destinations.

Hundreds of thousands of workers were stranded in suburban communities throughout Italy by the railroad stoppage. The government put on extra buses and arranged special flights for long distance passengers.

Most cities reported their post-offices were open but mail deliveries had stopped.

Private contact telephone facilities and some government long lines were in operation.

**Recent Rains Fill
Town Reservoirs**

For West Hill residents who have been complaining some days and water softeners in large quantities for the past few months, relief is here—at least until the next drought.

Fred Thrall, assistant superintendent of the Water Dept., said today that the well at Love Lane, which pumps hard water into the system when the reservoirs begin going down, has been shut off for the winter.

Some West Hillers have had to put up with hard water during the drought but recent rainfalls have brought the town's impounded supply to within almost one hundred million gallons of capacity.

With a record rainfall in October, the town's reservoirs now contain 285,300,000 gallons. Maximum capacity is 300,000,000 gallons.

In October, 4.3 inches fell at Porter Reservoir while the 50 year average for that month is 3.09 inches. November rainfall was 3.61 inches, only two tenths less than the 50 year average. With only one third the month gone by, 5.06 inches have fallen so far in December, a month for which 3.70 is the average.

Winsted, Dec. 11 (AP)—When a man reaches his 80th birthday, nobody would deny him the right to sit back in his chair and watch the world drift by.

Not so for Thomas A. Haggerty, veteran editor of the Daily Winsted Citizen who reaches his four-score birthday.

For Haggerty tomorrow will be a special day, his 80th birthday—but it also will be a working day which will start as usual at 7 a.m. and end around 4 p.m., with no time out for lunch. He'll grab a bite where and when he can.

That's the pace Tom Haggerty set for himself in 1929 when he came from North Adams, Mass., to assume the managing editorship of the Citizen and it's a pace he has followed down through the 24th annual. Tom Haggerty went on to deliver his telegrams on his 80th birthday.

Haggerty actually started his newspaper career in 1906 when he and his brothers Michael, William and Stephen founded the North Adams, Mass. Herald. Although he was the printing foreman and had the first stick of type in the editorial side.
