### New School Bus Policies Set up by School Board

Coventry, Feb. 17 (Special—Local school bus drivers and the Board of Education have discussed and set up revised operating policies concerning transportation of school children. Of particular importance to parents is the board ruling which requires all children leaving the school bus to cross the street in front of the bus at the driver's direction.

There have been many violations of this rule. The board chairman Jesse A. Brainard said several near accidents have occurred despits the drivers' best efforts to prevent them.

The board has also adopted a new ruling which prohibits eating on all school buses.

Brainard cautions all high school students who drive their own cars to maintain safe and legal distances from School buses at all times. There have been a number of complaints received by the board, he said, in this regard and all fullure singletons will be seened.
