Firm's Plastic Division To Continue Operation In Manchester, Supply Work for About 45

The Rogers Corp., which has gradually been transferring its operations to Goodyear, announced today that all of its administrative and other office functions have been moved to the eastern Connecticut plant site.

The closing of the eastern base all but ends the company's association with the town, which began in 1923 when the Rogers Paper Manufacturing Co. was established in Manchester.

GOP Speaker

A company spokesman said the firm's plastic division, which provides work for some 45 employees, will remain in Manchester. He said the firm sees no reason for moving the division, which is a complete unit in itself, because it is running efficiently here.

Although the corporation's offices have, until now, been located on Hill St. here, all other divisions and operations have been concentrated in the firm's larger quarters at Goodyear for about the last 10 years.

The hospital library staff's attention is devoted largely to billing special services to patients.

"Less than two months after the service began, it was expanded to include a weekly story hour in each of the six children's wards. Patients who must lie on their backs while reading are supplied with prismatized glasses. With these glasses, the patient doesn't have to prop up, or raise his head. He can just lie there and read the book he holds on his chest or stomach because the glass reflects the light to bend the light rays instead of bending his neck."

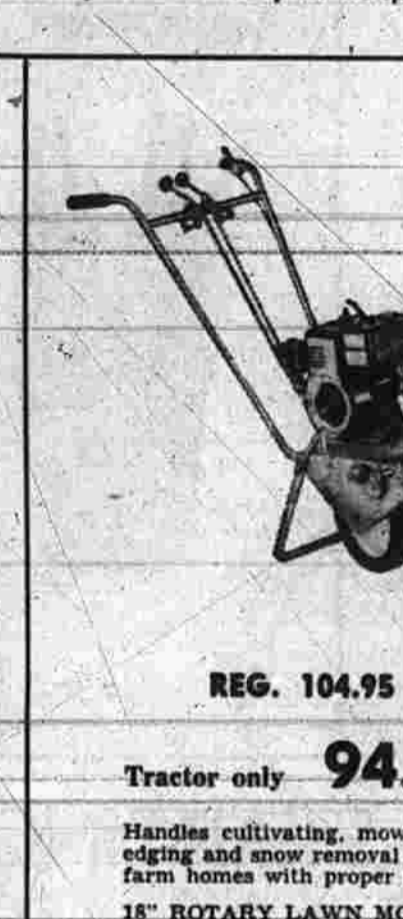

Coventry New School Bus Policies Set up by School Board

Coventry, Feb. 17 (Special)—Local school bus drivers and the Board of Education have discussed and set up revised operating policies concerning transportation of school children. Of particular importance to parents in the board ruling which requires all children leaving the school bus to stand in front of the bus at the driver's direction.

There have been many violations of this rule. The board chairman Jesse A. Brainard said several recent accidents have occurred due to the drivers' best efforts to prevent them.

The board has also adopted a new ruling which prohibits sitting on all school buses. Brainard cautions all high school students who drive their own cars to maintain safe and legal distances from school buses at all times.

Other rules and regulations established for pupil conduct on the buses include the following: The bus driver is in complete charge of the bus and all passengers; all passengers shall follow the instructions issued by the driver for loading, unloading and personal conduct; pupils shall not stand while the bus is in motion; pupils shall enter and leave buses in an orderly fashion.

There shall be no interference with anyone passing to or from his or her seat entering or leaving the bus; there shall be no smoking or lighting of matches on the school buses; there shall be no throwing of objects on such buses; the use of profanity is absolutely forbidden.

There shall be no destruction of bus property; pupils who cause damage to any bus are responsible for the cost of repairs; the operator must report all cases of misconduct to the principal; pupils who misbehave are subject to suspension and may be referred to the State Board of Education.

The State Board of Education says "No person shall be allowed to operate a bus without a license or personal carelessness. Any pupil whose conduct endangers the safety of others, should be referred to the State Board of Education."

The Board felt the purpose of adopting such policies was necessary in that educational standards require transportation if the children are to have equal educational opportunity. The Board of Education endeavors to provide adequate and economical transportation to permit every child attending school for the full year.
