

Actually there may be a better timing or spacing for the booster shot to create the most protection and this question is being studied. It's also possible that only one initial or sensitizing shot is needed, followed by one booster later.

Well, you may ask, if the vaccine creates antibodies, why is there any doubt that it won't protect the children?

There are two questions. One is whether the virus can attack nerves without going through the bloodstrean; where the antibodies are standing guard.

The evidence is that most of us get polio because he virus enters the intestinal tract, then gets into the bloodstream, and then moves on to attack the nerves.

But there is evidence that sometimes it can by-pass the bloodstream, thus escaping attack by the antibodies.
