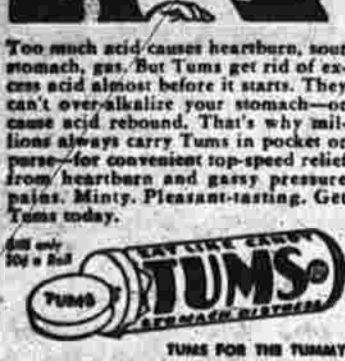

It would have been better, actually, to have found some notable character so far removed from the stream of American living that he had never met his foe in the McCarthy case. No doubt, that any such ideal character could have been found. And, if there is to be any indication of previous settlement of the case, the open trial counsel, it is better to have it settled for McCarthy.

Quite obviously, we do not say this because we favor the McCarthy side of the controversy. We say it, quite frankly, because we would rather have McCarthy have some superficial advantage than have an appearance of an alibi after the thing is over.

A second question about the probe would also answer in favor of McCarthy, this time on a basis of principle.

Ever since the probe has been stated, there has been a possibility that the probe would be exercised to the right to cross-examine witnesses. Many of these would be people who, throughout McCarthy's investigating career, have repeatedly criticized his failure to seek out witnesses before him the privilege of cross-examining his accusers. Now that McCarthy himself is about to come under investigation, these take the position that he should be handled by his own past standards, which these same critics judged to be wrong when he established them, rather than by the standards which are right in principle. But if it is right to cross-examine McCarthy, it is right in another, even if the individual to whom the privilege is to be extended happens to be an individual who has refused to extend it to others.

Real Security

Even those who have leveled much criticism at each, and for its lack of attention to questions of the national security will, we think, turn to sincere admiration when they contemplate how we have handled the problem posed by the presence of one Mrs. Dora W. Grace, a British subject, at the United Nations.

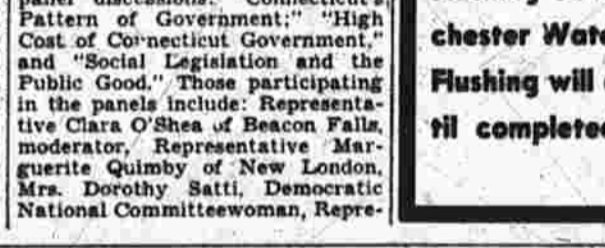
