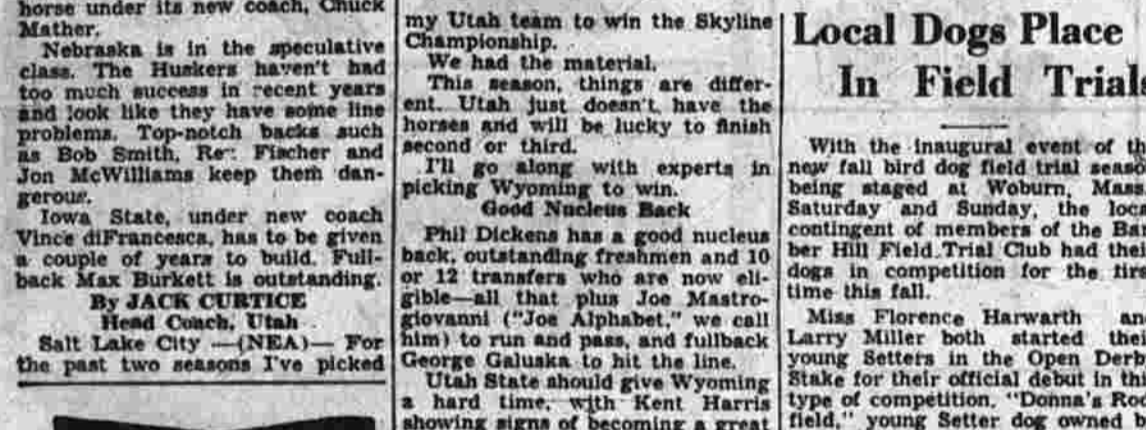

Eight Nations Sign SEATO Pact to Halt Red Gains in Asia

Manila, Sept. 8 (AP)—Eight nations of the East and the West today signed a collective security pact which in effect warned the Communists against any further aggression in southeast Asia. The treaty hangs a big "no trespassing" sign of small nations in the area. It binds the eight nations militarily and economically and declares each party will meet the "common danger" of armed attack in the treaty area against any member "in accordance with its constitutional process."

Australia's Richard G. Casey was first to sign the historic document. He began affixing his signature to the various copies at 9:02 a. m. (5:02 a. m. EDT).
