Oranville. There was some damage but first reports said there were no casualties.

Rescue teams returning here said identification of European victims was proceeding rapidly but that they were having more difficulty with the Moslem dead. Casualty estimates were made more difficult by the fact that many Moslems were burying their own dead without sending in any report.

The French Interior Ministry said last night 960 deaths had been confirmed officially, but that most of them appeared to be European residents of the area. They said an accurate accounting of the quake toll will take many days.

clusion of a rearmored West Germany in a European defense system would strengthen the West in its dealings with Russia.

"Such statements are absolutely groundless," the Soviets said. "In reality, it is quite the contrary. The rearmament of West Germany and drawing her into any military grouping would create insurmountable difficulties for uniting Germany and consequently would make it impossible to reach an agreement on the German question."

This means the whole German nation would remain torn in two parts for an indefinite period. In itself creates a dangerous situation.

The statement, apparently aimed at attracting European support for Russia's position, stressed the danger to France of a rearmored Germany. It warned that such a development would reduce France to a second rate power.

The statement hailed the French Parliament's rejection of the European Defense Community (EDC) declaration.

"It testifies how France realizes the danger connected with turning West Germany into a militarist state, the fate of which would be in the hands of German reactionaries who are seeking to recover lost territory or power," it also shows the power of the patriotic forces in France that justly saw in the creation of EDC a deadly menace to the security of the French state."

The statement described EDC's aim as a "serious blow to the world aggressive military groups of states whose sponsors are the United States ruling circles."

In Bonn, meanwhile, Chancellor Konrad Adenauer plunged today into a hot state election battle that seriously menaces his home-front prestige.

The 78-year-old Rhineland Catholic, whose dream of a European union with German divisions had been a "terrible blow to the world aggressive military groups of states whose sponsors are the United States ruling circles."

Law Codification Nears Completion

Ally Paul Marte is codifying the town's by-laws and says most of his preliminary work has been completed in preparation for a review with Town Counsel Charles N. Crockett in the near future.

The last codification was made in 1943 and since then a number of the laws have become outdated or superseded by newer ordinances, Marte said. Terms such as "election" and "first selection" will have to be changed throughout to the newer terms of "director" and "general manager" since the adoption of the new town charter, the attorney said.

Besides the codification, Marte said will make recommendations to the directors to bring the by-laws up to date.
