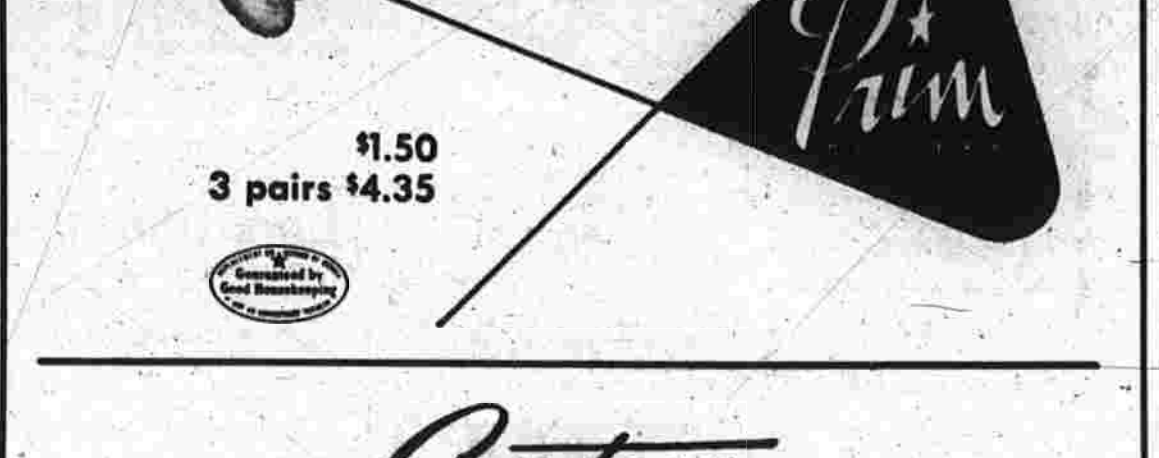

### Rockville Town Receives \$75,000 Grant In School Aid

Rockville, Oct. 23 (Special)—Raymond E. Ramsdell, assistant superintendent of schools, announced today that the town of Rockville has been granted \$75,000 by the U. S. Dept. of Health, Education and Welfare to improve school facilities.

The action by this federal government agency stems from a formal request made Aug. 9 at which time a special town meeting adopted a resolution requesting the funds under the provision of Public Law 874 Section 4e.

The money cannot be used toward the cost of any new school building and cannot be put in the hands of the town. The sale proceeds of the allotment is for the improvement of existing school facilities.

Several months ago Franklin Wiles explained the details necessary to gain the procurement to the Board of Education. Ramsdell worked with the selectmen securing the facts and figures necessary for the formal request.

Parents in Defense Work

According to the bill which permits the number of children attending local schools is to be determined by the parents. Ramsdell said that the town of Rockville is one of the few towns in the state which are eligible to receive this grant.

The research done by Wiles and Ramsdell showed that 240 pupils were in local schools whose parents were employed in defense work on government contracts.

News of the approval was received by Ramsdell in the form of a letter signed by David McQueen, director of maintenance work in the office of the school assistance program.

In the letter it was said the formal grant would be sent within a few days.

"Though members of the board were optimistic that the grant would be as high as \$75,000, this figure was arrived at after comparison of the local area with other towns in the state. The grant will be used for the purchase of new desks and chairs for the classrooms.

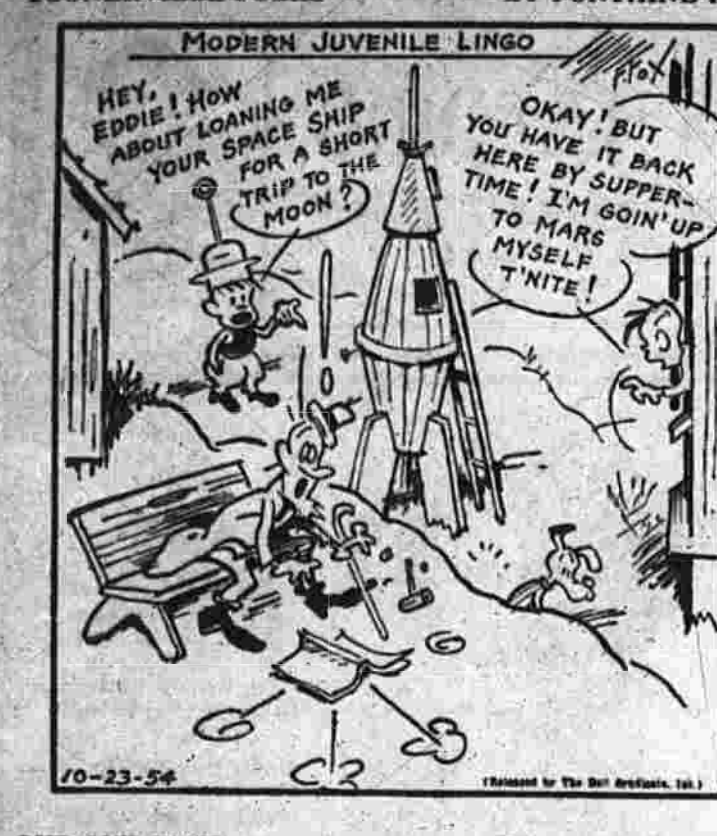

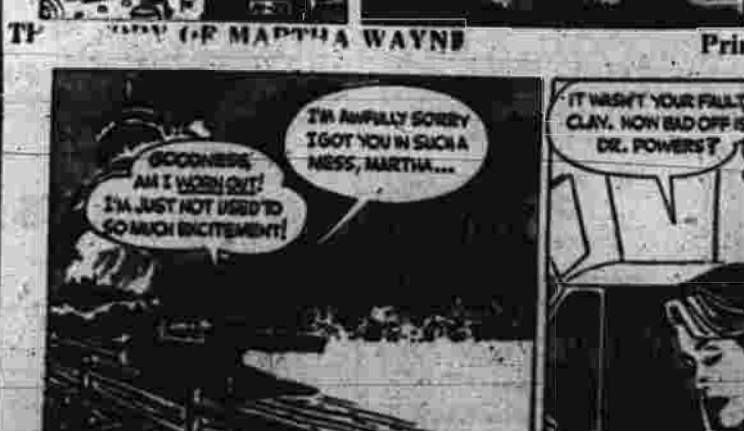
